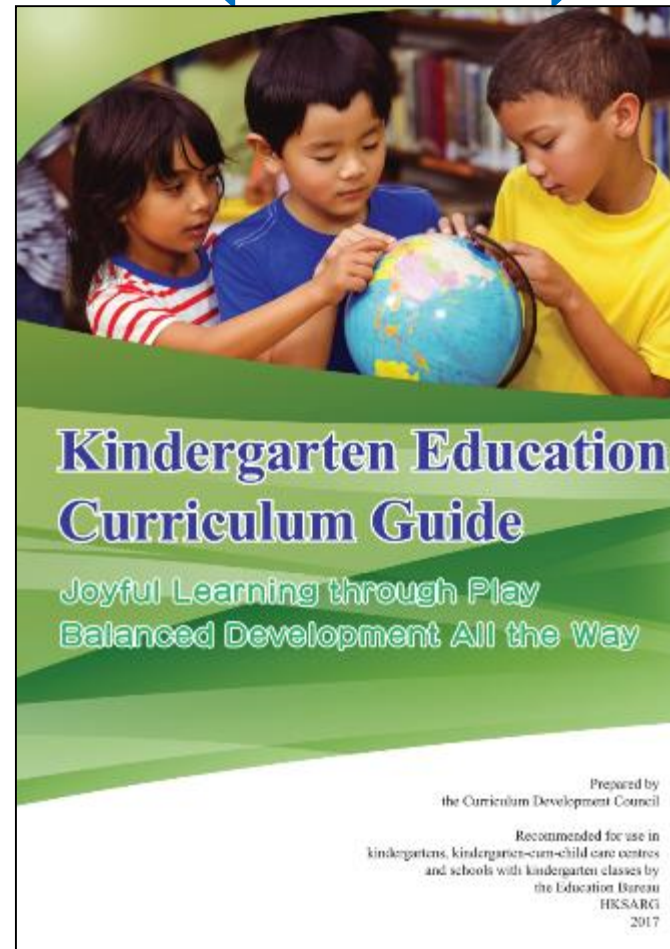
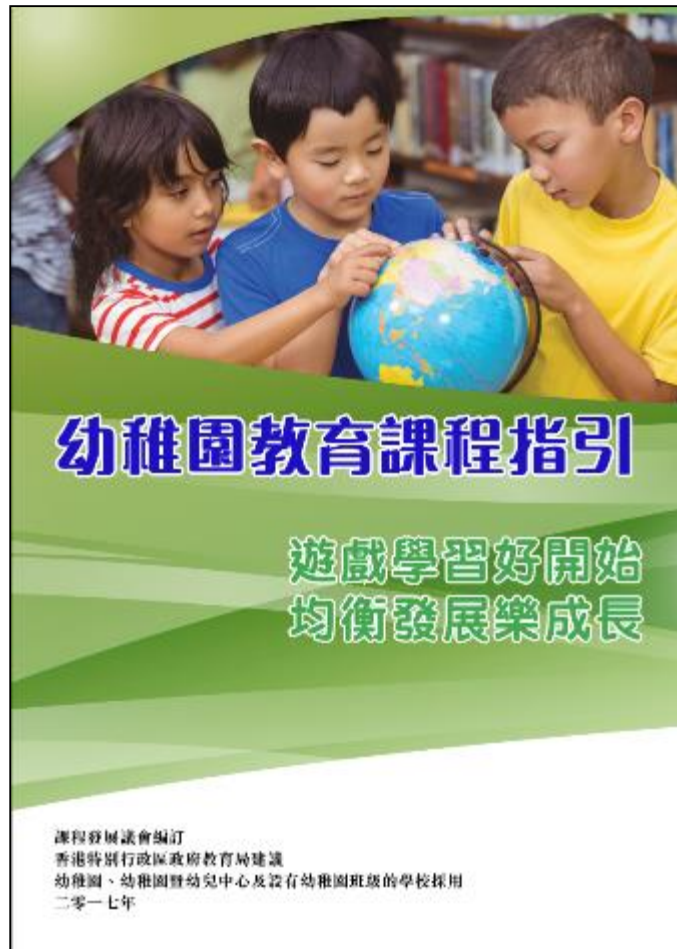
Objectives of Kindergarten Education

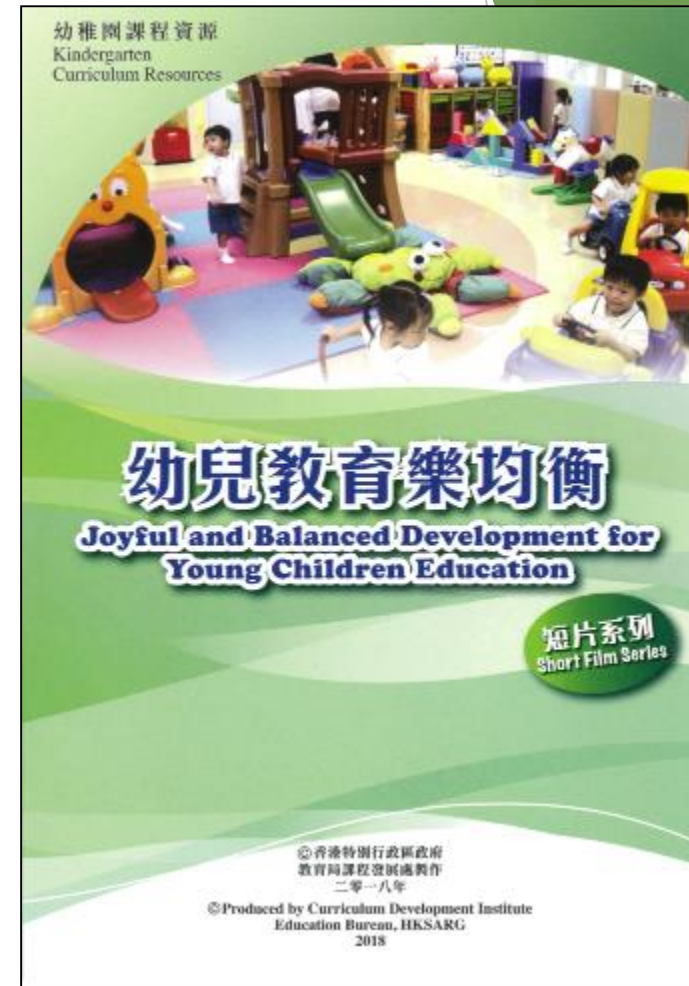

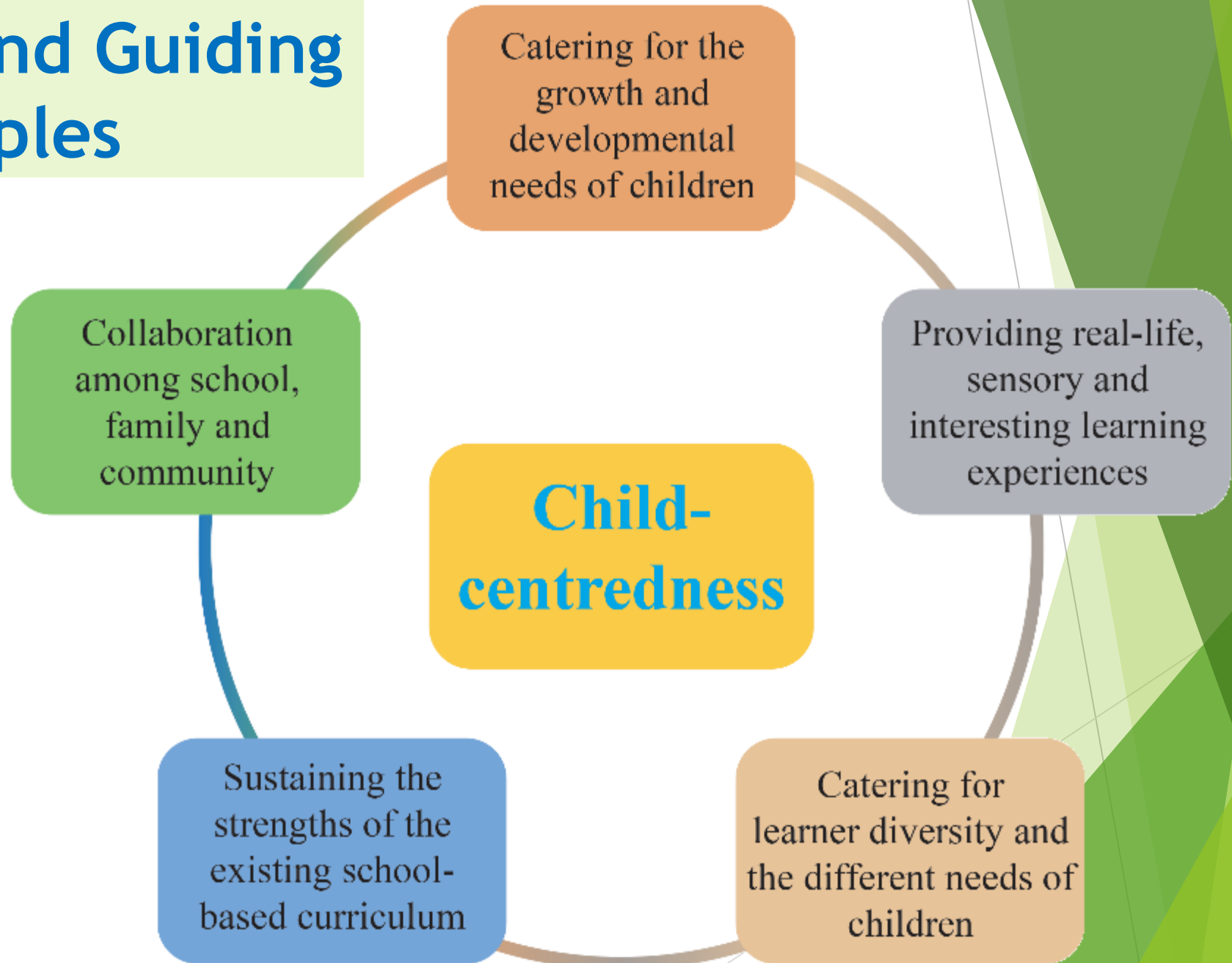

To foster children's

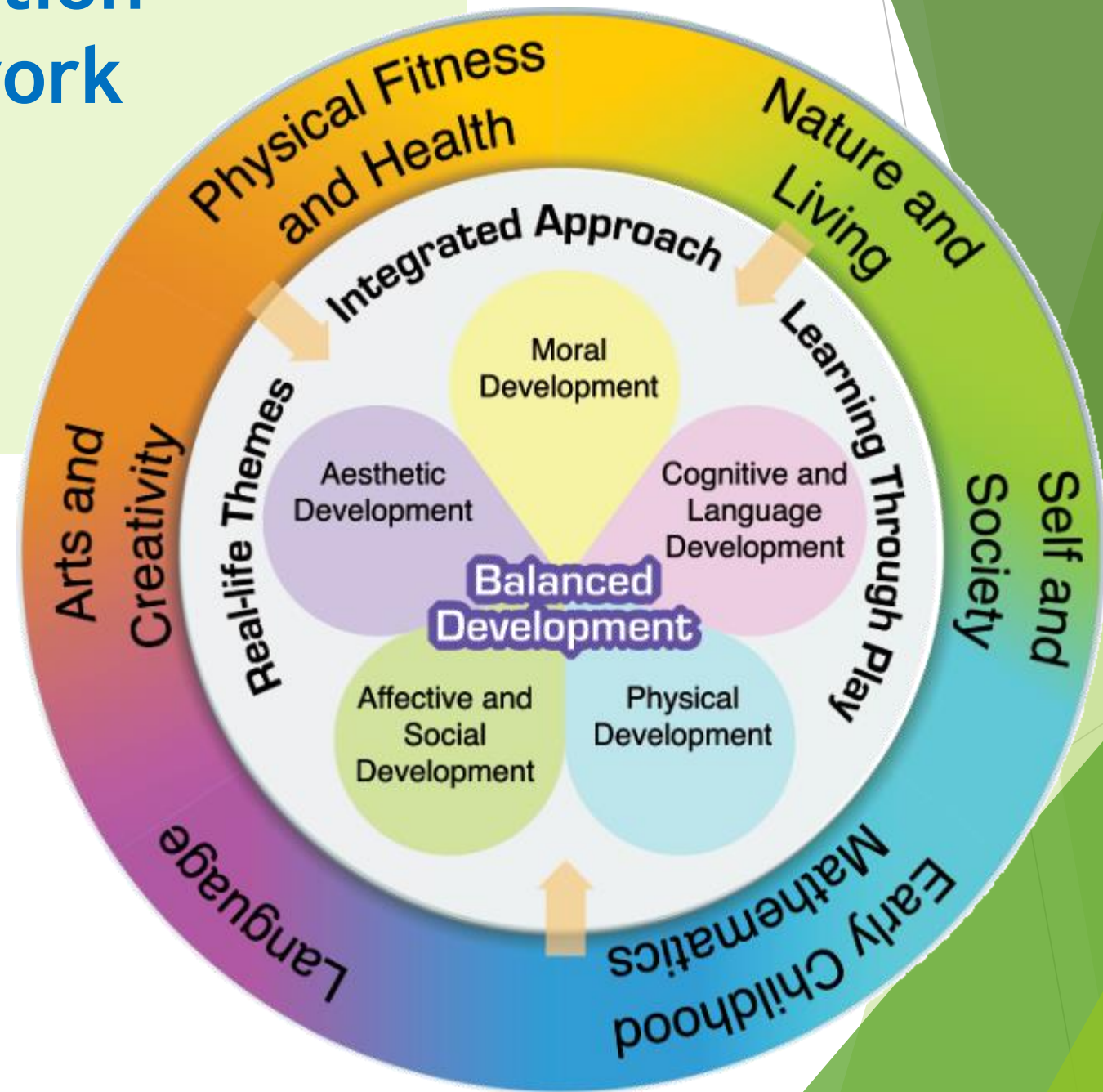
- ▶ balanced development in the domains of ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics
- ▶ good living habits and development of a strong and healthy body
- ▶ interest in learning, inquisitive mind and eagerness to explore
- ▶ positive values and attitudes

The Learning Characteristics of Children

- ▶ Children are full of curiosity and take an active role in learning
- ▶ **Children have different modes of learning**
- ▶ Children enjoy using senses to learn new things
- ▶ **Children acquire new knowledge based on their prior experiences and skills**
- ▶ Children love to learn in an accepting, encouraging and supportive environment

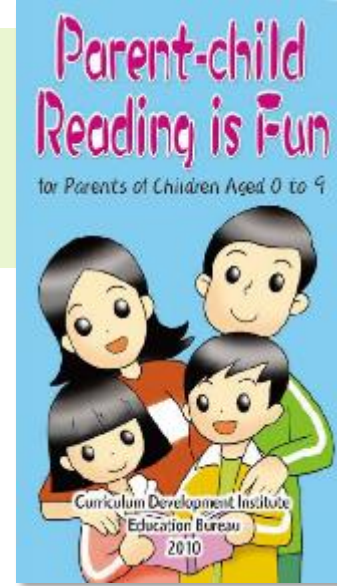

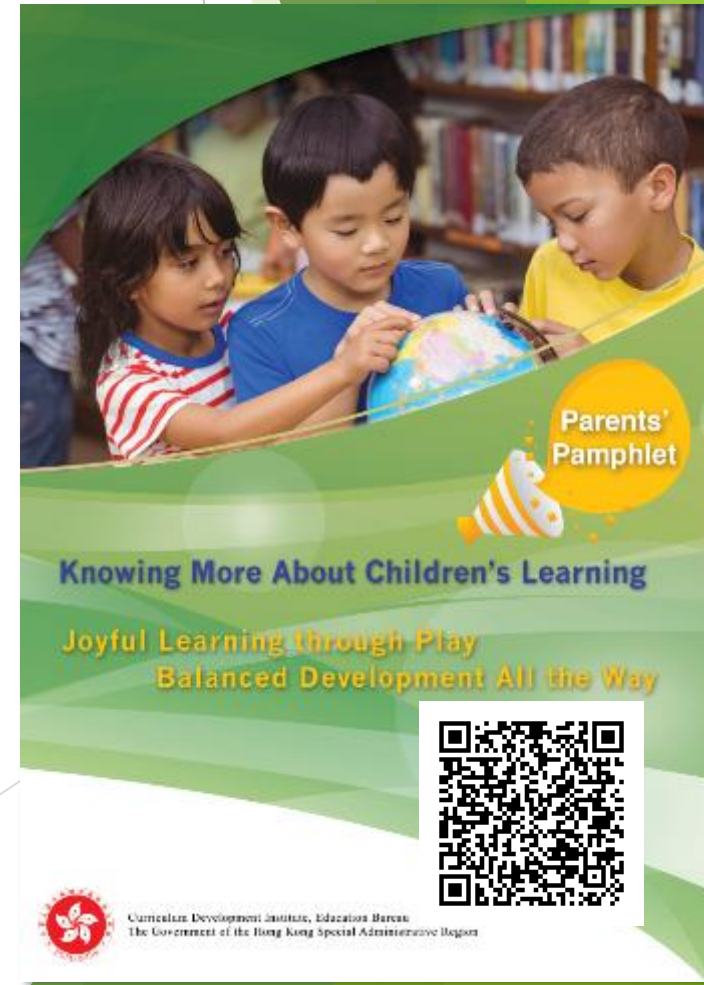
