## **Digital Education Week 2025**

### Inspiring Future Generations Through Innovative Learning and Teaching

#### **Summary**

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to inform kindergartens, primary, secondary, and special schools of the Digital Education Week 2025. All school heads and teachers are invited to attend the event.

#### **Details**

- 2. The Education Bureau announced that the Digital Education Week (DEW) 2025, a landmark event promoting digital transformation in education, will be held from 30 June to 7 July 2025. DEW 2025 integrates the flagship Learning & Teaching Expo (LTE) with the International Summit on the Use of AI in Learning and Teaching Languages and Other Subjects and Post-summit Workshop Series (AIinLT). Together, these events will promote cross-sector collaboration and showcase cutting-edge innovations on educational technology (EdTech), including the adoption of artificial intelligence (AI), to enhance learning and teaching effectiveness.
- 3. Themed 'Education: A Shared Future for All', LTE 2025 is presented by Hong Kong Education City (EdCity), organised by the Smart City Consortium and supported by the Education Bureau as Asia's leading education expo. LTE offers educators, school leaders, and EdTech innovators with a dynamic platform for sustainable development in exploration of the latest developmental trends on learning and teaching, EdTech resources for cutting-edge solutions, and shape the future of education collaboratively. The expo will feature 600+ local and overseas exhibitions, 270+ programmes, and 300+ international speakers sharing learning solutions for future classrooms, with a strong focus on integrating AI and EdTech into teaching of different subjects. #### Highlights of LTE 2025:

- e-Learning Ancillary Facilities Programme (eLAFP): The Hong Kong Productivity Council will facilitate the showcase of the first-phase outcomes of the eLAFP and organise related sharing sessions;
- **Principals' Conference:** Cover education trends, digital literacy, and wellness, with insights from global experts and pioneering case studies;

- Mainland and Asian Pavilion: Showcase the latest EdTech innovations and foster cross-cultural collaboration among educators from Mainland China, Singapore, and other regions;
- **Kids' AI Summit and Competition:** Engage students in live competitions to showcase creativity and problem-solving in AI, robotics, culture, and entrepreneurship;
- Language Learning Hub: Interactive workshops and teaching demonstration offer educators with creative pedagogies and tools to help students master language learning effectively; and
- **Startup Circle:** Connect educators with EdTech startups for interactions on innovative solutions. The area also engages students who aspire to commence an entrepreneur career in the future in dialogue with the startup entrepreneurs for a better understanding of the field.
- 4. **AlinLT** provides a valuable platform for teachers, researchers, and other members of the education sector to gather, learn, and exchange insights on AI applications across diverse disciplines. #### Highlights of AlinLT:

- **Keynote Speeches (4-5 July):** It features five prominent keynote speakers, namely Professor Victor Lee from Stanford University, Professor Siu-cheung Kong from EDUHK, Professor Hongxia Yang from PolyU, Professor Xin Lyu from Communication University of China, and Mr. Andreas Schleicher, Director for Education and Skills, OECD;
- Panel Discussion (4 July): There will be an expert panel discussion focusing on issues related to the use of AI in education in the local education context;
- Presentations and Teaching Demonstrations (4-5 July): Approximately 100 paper presentations and teaching demonstrations by scholars and teachers from around the world will be featured;
- **Post-Summit Workshop Series (6-7 July):** There will be 11 workshops on a wide range of topics specially designed for teachers to enhance classroom instruction through practical handson experience on various AI-powered tools; and
- **Technology Showcase (6-7 July):** It will feature the latest AI hardware and software solutions from as many as 20 leading EdTech providers, offering educators firsthand exposure to cutting edge-innovations.

#### **Enhancing Participant Experience**

5. DEW 2025 introduces the **Guided Development Path**, offering personalised development recommendations tailored to educators' roles and visit preferences. Accessible through the **EdCity Teacher App**, this feature guides educators to relevant programmes, booths and networking opportunities within LTE 2025 and AlinLT, enhancing their overall experience. Participants who attend and check in to the recommended programmes and activities along the path will receive a certificate. For more information, refer to Appendix 3.

6. Schools are encouraged to designate LTE 2025 and AlinLT as major staff professional

development activities. Attendance reports and certificates of participation will be provided by the organisers, and participants can record their CPD hours in their personal profiles on the e-Services Portal.

7. LTE 2025 and AIinLT are now open for registration. Educators can enroll for a free admission badge and pre-register for programmes of interest.


