Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to invite kindergartens, primary and secondary schools to participate in the coming educational activities and events organised, coorganised or announced by Curriculum and Quality Assurance Branch, Education Bureau (EDB). When arranging learning activities and relevant learning and teaching resources for students (including printed and electronic library collections and other reading and curriculum materials for students), schools should ensure that the activities are in line with the learning goals and curriculum objectives, the learning needs of students are catered for, and the safety of students and teachers are taken into account. Please refer to the relevant circulars and guidelines issued by the EDB for the points to note in arranging activities. In addition, the content and quality of the learning and teaching resources of individual Key Learning Areas (KLAs) and cross-curricular subjects in the school should be regularly reviewed in order to ensure that the content and information contained in learning and teaching resources are accurate, complete, objective and impartial, and emphasise the development of proper values, positive attitudes, and appropriate behaviours among students.

The EDB continuously uploads and updates National Education-related teachers' professional development programmes, students' activities, learning and teaching resources and examples for "National Education - Event Planning Calendar", etc. on "National Education One-stop Portal". Please visit http://www.edb.gov.hk/en/neosp/ to obtain latest information. Key dates in



December and January include "Constitution Day" on 4 December, "Nanjing Massacre National Memorial Day" on 13 December and "New Year's Day" on 1 January.





6. In order to plan and promote national education in a systematic and holistic manner, schools can introduce the Constitution and the Basic Law on exhibition panels, organise inter-class or inter-level quizzes on the Constitution and the Basic Law, or arrange related parent-child

learning activities on the Constitution Day or the preceding/following days; explain the historical facts of Nanjing Massacre in school assemblies or related lessons preceding or following the "Nanjing Massacre National Memorial Day", make arrangements for observing a moment of silence in the school to commemorate the victims and pay tribute to the martyrs' spirit of patriotism, and arrange field trips relating to the history of the War of Resistance to enable students to experience the indomitable spirit of the Chinese nation; as well as organise celebration activities including the national flag raising ceremony and the playing and singing of the national anthem on New Year's Day or the preceding/following school days, by adopting the approaches of "organic integration", "natural connection", "diversified strategies", "mutual co-ordination", "learning within and beyond the classroom", and "whole-school participation".

7. In addition, the EDB has provided online "Curriculum Resources on the Use of Cognitive/ Thinking Tools". Students are welcome to participate in the related course and make use of the thinking tools when participating in educational activities and competitions to enhance their analytical, organisational and creative skills.

To help primary and secondary students recognise that digital education is closely related to our lives and enhance their interest in learning information and digital technologies, the Education Bureau (EDB) and the Hong Kong Education City (EdCity) jointly organise the "Blueprint for Digital Education Development in Primary and Secondary Schools" Cover Design Selection (the Selection).

"Blueprint for Digital Education Development in Primary and Secondary Schools" Cover Design Selection

Sections

• Primary Section: Primary 1-6 students

• Secondary Section: Secondary 1-6 students

Title of the Cover

Blueprint for Digital Education Development in Primary and Secondary Schools

Design Elements

• The design of the cover must include the aforementioned cover title and elements of digital education such as artificial intelligence, and innovation and technology. Other suggested design elements include various educational settings and parties (such as teachers, students, and other stakeholders) involved in the promotion of digital education in Hong Kong primary and secondary schools, as well as other theme-related elements.

Activity Details

- Students should enter the Selection through their school.
- Each participating student must submit the entry (limited to one entry) to his/her school.
- There is no limit on the participating number of entries for a school. Each student must have a coaching teacher, and each teacher may coach more than one student.
- Schools can arrange this activity in class; subject teachers may incorporate this activity as one of the assignments and provide guidance to students during class.
- Each student should also submit* a <u>short writing of no less than 100 words</u> (in Chinese or English) **OR** a <u>short video of approximately one minute</u>**, to explain the creative idea of the cover design.

*If generative AI tools are used to assist in designing the cover, the prompts or text descriptions used to guide the AI-generated content must also be submitted.

**Requirements for short videos:

- ➤ Videos may be edited and enhanced by post-production and technical adjustments (e.g. music, subtitles, animations, photos, virtual backgrounds, presentation slides, etc.).
- ➤ If participating students choose to explain the creative idea in person in the video, they must wear neat school uniform.
- Participating students must submit a written script that aligns with the video content.

- Schools must submit a list of participating students to the EDB. The list concerned will be counted towards the "Active Participating School Award", and each participating student will receive an electronic certificate of participation.
- Schools may recommend <u>ONE</u> outstanding entry from all participating entries and must submit the respective "Declaration and Consent Form" for the original work and authorisation. The "Declaration and Consent Form" can be downloaded from the following EdCity webpage. Schools are not required to submit entries which are not recommended.

Rules and Regulations

- Entries must be a full-colour graphic design in <u>A4</u> size (210 mm x 297 mm).
- The text on the cover shall be in **Chinese or English**.
- Entries must be in line with the theme and have <u>never been published or entered into other</u> <u>competitions/selections</u>.
- Information related to the participating schools or the participating students should not be displayed on the entries.
- The resolution of the electronic file should be no less than 600dpi.
- Participating students must keep their work (including the cover, short writing/video, and/or prompts or text descriptions for AI-generated content) until the end of this school year.

Submission of Entries

- The entry form can be downloaded from the EdCity webpage (https://www.hkedcity.net/registration/form.php?reg_form_id=1453). Please fill in the relevant information accurately as required.
- The electronic file of the cover must be in JPEG/ PDF/ PNG format; the short writing must be in DOC or PDF format; and the video must be in MP4 format with a minimum resolution of 1920 x 1080 and a landscape aspect ratio of 4:3 or 16:9. Entries that cannot be viewed or downloaded due to technical issues will be disqualified.
- Only the recommended outstanding entry and the respective attachments need to be uploaded by schools.
- The name of the electronic file of each entry must include the abbreviated Chinese name of the school and the name of the student, for example:
 "杏壇中學陳一心.pdf" / "杏壇中學陳一心.jpg". If the student
 - does not have a Chinese name, please fill in an English name.
- Schools must upload the completed entry form, entries and att achments to the EdCity webpage (https://www.hkedcity.net/regis



<u>tration/form.php?reg_form_id=1453</u>) <u>on or before 30 January 2026 (Friday)</u>. Late submissions or submissions without required attachments will not be accepted.

Adjudication

- Outstanding Entries: Each school may recommend <u>ONE</u> outstanding entry from the list of participating entries.
- Excellent Entries: Outstanding entries will be shortlisted, after which the adjudication panel will select **FIVE** excellent entries based on the adjudication criteria.
- The decision of the adjudication panel shall be final and subject to no appeal.

Adjudication Criteria

- Relevance to the theme
- Creative design
- Execution of media techniques

Awards

- The following awards will be given to each section:
 - > Individual awards:
 - Commemorative certificates for schools' recommended outstanding entries.
 - Trophies and commemorative certificates for excellent entries selected by adjudication panel.

> School awards:

- The "Active Participating School Award" will be awarded to the top ten schools with the most student entries in each section.
- The "Most Active Participating School Award" will be awarded to the school with the most student entries in each section.
- Each participating student will receive an electronic certificate of participation.

Use of Entries

- Outstanding entries may be selected as the cover of the Blueprint. The EDB has the right to consolidate, enrich, and/or use all or part of the content of the entries for enhancing the presentation of the theme of the Blueprint.
- The EDB may use all or part of the content (including the school name) of the outstanding entries (including the covers and the short writings/videos) for the promotion of digital education, such as publicity, display (including but not limited to physical exhibitions, uploading to the webpages or social media platforms), or other non-profit-making purposes.
- With the prior consent from parents and students, the EDB recommends schools to upload

the entries to the school websites for viewing by parents and the public.

Announcement of Results

The awardees' lists will be announced on the EDB website (https://www.edb.gov.hk/en/edu-system/primary-secondary/applicable-to-primary-secondary/it-in-edu/index.html) at the end of April 2026. Schools of the respective awardees and the awarded schools will be notified by post.



Points to Note for Schools/Participating Students

- The EDB reserves the right to change, suspend or terminate the activity at any time. If there are any changes, announcements will be made on the EDB and the EdCity website.
- The EDB reserves the right to change the awards without prior notice.
- After submitting the online entry form, schools should notify the EDB if they need to amend any information. Once an entry is submitted, it cannot be modified or re-uploaded.
- Participating schools should keep the master copies of the entries (including the covers and the short writings/videos) until the end of this school year.
- The entry submission date and time will be determined by the timestamps recorded on the EdCity's server system.
- Participating schools should ensure that the information and content in their entries are in line with the aims and objectives of curriculum set out by the EDB, contain no element of obscenity, abuse, violence, defamation and endangerment to national security, etc., and do not violate the laws of the HKSAR. Otherwise, the participating students will be disqualified.
- Participating students and their respective schools must ensure that the content of their work does not infringe any copyrights, publication rights or any other rights. Otherwise, the participating students will be disqualified for participation and awards, and the participating students shall be solely responsible for any disputes arising therefrom. The EDB and the EdCity will not bear any legal responsibilities arising from copyright infringement. For details, please visit the Intellectual Property Department website:

If participating students fail to provide such personal data, the EDB may not accept their entries for the activity.



2. Details of the "Hong Kong Tourism Industry Student Summit – Keynote Speech Session"

- (a) Schools can nominate Senior Secondary THS students to attend the Keynote Speech Session, and are encouraged to assign at least one group of students among them to participate in the Inter-school Project Learning Competition and attend its Sharing Session.
- (b) The Keynote Speech Session will be conducted in hybrid mode (face-to-face and real-time online modes). The participants of the Inter-school Project Learning Competition must attend the Keynote Speech Session in face-to-face mode while the organisers will arrange the mode of delivery for the remaining participants depending on the enrolment situation. The application results will be confirmed via email on or before 16 January 2026 (Friday).

3. Details of the "Hong Kong Tourism Industry Student Summit – Inter-school Photo Contest"

The Inter-school Photo Contest, newly introduced this year, aims to encourage students to rediscover the 18 districts in Hong Kong, using their creativity and cameras to explore the diverse tourism resources and potential in the local community, and to promote the unique attractions in the 18 districts through captioned photos, showcasing Hong Kong's charm.

A. Rules

- (a) All Senior Secondary THS students can enter the photo contest as individual entrants. Each participant shall submit only one entry; otherwise, he/she will be disqualified. Only the first submitted version will be adjudicated.
- (b) The entries should showcase Hong Kong's distinctive allure and diverse vibrancy through **the hidden spots or the lesser-known tourism appeal of hot spots** in the 18 districts in Hong Kong.
- (c) Each entry should have a file size not exceeding 10 megabytes (MB) and a resolution of at least 1,600 pixels wide (in landscape mode) or 1,600 pixels tall (in

portrait mode). All entries must be saved in JPEG, JPG or PNG format, accompanied by an entry title and a description within 100 words. The file should be named in the format, i.e. School Name_Entrant Name (e.g. ABC College_Chan Tai Man.jpg).

- (d) All entries must be the participants' original works which have not been released or used in other competitions.
- (e) Participants must obtain lawful authority from persons appearing in the entries. Also, all entries must not infringe on the copyrights or any other rights of others, or violate the laws of the HKSAR. The organisers will not assume liabilities for any inappropriate content of the entries.
- (f) All entries should not contain any material that is obscene, violent, pornographic, defamatory, indecent, disparaging or content that is controversial and inappropriate.
- (g) Minor modifications to the works, such as cropping, dust removal, and reasonable adjustment of exposure, colour, contrast and white balance, are acceptable. However, entries that are computer-generated, artificial intelligence-generated or have undergone excessive post-processing by any means will not be accepted. The original digital files must be retained for review and verification by the organisers if needed.
- (h) Entries failing to follow the above requirements may result in marks penalty or even disqualification.
- (i) Entries should be submitted to the specific platform by teachers in-charge on or before 5 pm, 27 March 2026 (Friday). The link for submission will be sent to teachers in-charge via email by 16 January, 2026 (Friday). Late submissions will not be entertained.

B. Adjudication

The adjudicating panel is comprised of representatives from the CDI of the EDB and the Hong Kong Tourism Board. Students' entries will be judged according to the following criteria and weighting:

4. Details of the "Hong Kong Tourism Industry Student Summit – Inter-school Project Learning Competition"

A. Rules

- (a) Schools can assign Senior Secondary THS students to participate in the Interschool Project Learning Competition. Each group shall consist of 3-5 students. There is no limit on the number of team participants from each school.
- (b) The organisers will assign one of the 18 districts in Hong Kong as the topic to each group by drawing lots. Each group shall select distinctive and novel tourism resources (including attractions and tourism services such as food and beverage, accommodation and transportation) in the designated district to write a proposal. On top of a brief overview of the tourism resources, each group shall make creative and feasible suggestions on these resources, such as introducing new facilities, events and smart elements, with a view to crafting unique tourism products which bring refreshing experience for visitors.
- (c) Successful registered schools will receive a confirmation email with the assigned topics for their groups on or before 16 January 2026 (Friday). Each group shall submit only one proposal. Only the first submitted version will be adjudicated.
- (d) The content of the proposal should be concise and relevant to the topic assigned. It can be written in either Chinese or English, with no more than 15 PowerPoint slides. No video or sound effects should be embedded.
- (e) The proposal must be submitted in the format of PowerPoint (.ppt / .pptx file) and named in the format, i.e. School Name_Topic (e.g. ABC College_Wanchai.pptx). The cover page of the proposal should contain basic

- information including the topic, school name, name of teacher in-charge and names of group members.
- (f) Participants must not plagiarise the work of others. If the content of any books or other references are cited in the proposal, the details of the sources, such as the names of the books or the URLs of websites, must be indicated clearly. The participating schools and students should respect intellectual property rights. The organisers will not be responsible for any legal liability arising from the copyright issues in relation to the content of the entries.
- (g) If artificial intelligence (AI) tools have been used for assisting in writing the proposal, participants must pay attention to the originality, accuracy and reliability of the content, and ensure that no copyrights or other intellectual property rights are infringed. When submitting the entry, participants must clearly indicate the process of using AI and must present the authorisation from the relevant software applications or platforms upon request by the organisers. Participants must not consider works generated by AI tools (including but not limited to generative AI) as their own creations, as doing so will be deemed plagiarism.
- (h) Entries failing to follow the above requirements may result in marks penalty or even disqualification.
- (i) The teacher in-charge is required to upload the proposals to the specific platform on or before 5 pm, 17 April 2026 (Friday). Late submissions will not be entertained. All proposals submitted will be first screened by the adjudicating panel. Groups shortlisted to the final stage of the competition will be notified by email on or before 29 April 2026 (Wednesday), and will be invited to give a presentation on their submitted proposal in no more than 7 minutes in the Sharing Session of Inter-school Project Learning Competition to present their learning outcomes.

B. Adjudication

The adjudicating panel is comprised of representatives from the CDI of the EDB and the Hong Kong Tourism Board. Students' entries will be judged according to the following criteria and weighting:

- (a) relevance to the theme and the unique characteristics of the district (25%);
- (b) innovativeness and creativity (20%);
- (c) feasibility of the suggestions (20%);
- (d) appropriate application of THS related concepts (20%);
- (e) well structured, concise and analytical presentation (15%)

The "Chemists Online" Self-study Award Scheme 2026

1. Introduction

The "Chemists Online" Self-study Award Scheme (COSAS) 2026 is jointly organised by the Hong Kong Virtual University (HKVU) and the Education Bureau. The aims of the Award Scheme are to enhance scientific literacy of senior secondary school students and to promote STEAM education by providing students with more advanced chemistry online lectures. In the 2025/26 school year, 27 online seminars will be provided to cover a wide range of chemistry topics, including drinking water treatment, synthetic polymers, nanomaterials and food chemistry, etc. These seminars were delivered by scholars from local universities and experts from chemistry-related industry.
