“AI in Education Forum Series & Showcase: eLAFP Deliverables & EdTech Solutions” Harnessing AI and Experiential Learning to Shape the Future of Digital Education

Summary

This circular memorandum serves to invite schools to participate in the “AI in Education Forum Series & Showcase: eLAFP Deliverables & EdTech Solutions” co-organised by the Education Bureau (EDB), Hong Kong Education City (EdCity) and Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC).

Background

2. In line with the national development of digital education and to nurture talent for the innovation and technology sector, the Chief Executive proposed in the 2025 Policy Address to further promote digital education in primary and secondary schools and to advance the relevant support measures put forward by the Steering Committee on Strategic Development of Digital Education. These include encouraging schools to use innovative technologies to support teaching, and optimising digital education ancillary infrastructure, etc. In this connection, the EDB launched the “AI for Empowering Learning and Teaching Funding Programme”¹ and Batch 2 project deliverables of the “e-Learning Ancillary Facilities Programme” (eLAFP)², funded by the Quality Education Fund (QEF), in mid-December 2025 and early January 2026 respectively. To promote the use of AI in empowering education, the EDB co-organises “AI in Education Forum Series & Showcase: eLAFP Deliverables & EdTech Solutions” with EdCity and HKPC.

Details

3. The “AI in Education Forum Series & Showcase: eLAFP Deliverables & EdTech Solutions” is scheduled to take place on **5 – 6 February 2026 (Thursday and Friday)** at the HKPC Building, 78 Tat Chee Avenue, Kowloon Tong. With the aim of enabling the school sector to better understand the latest technology trends and solutions, and master relevant knowledge and skills to enhance the effectiveness of learning and teaching, the event features Principal Panel, over 60 forums, seminars, workshops, demonstration lessons, EdTech solution showcases and eLAFP one-on-one consultation clinics that introduces relevant teaching applications and the 22 projects under the eLAFP.

- **Principal Panel**

A number of primary and secondary school principals will serve as guest speakers at the Principal Panel, sharing the challenges, opportunities and practical experiences encountered in applying AI to support teaching.

- **Forums**

Various experts and industry leaders will serve as keynote speakers at the forums, providing in-depth analysis of the latest trends of education and teaching strategies to support school leaders and teachers in understanding both international and local directions of education reform, and broadening their pedagogical perspectives.

- **Seminars, Workshops and Demonstration Lessons**

These sessions will focus on teaching practice and exchange of experiences, sharing practical teaching skills and strategies to help teachers enhance teaching effectiveness. Through teachers' sharing of real-life cases on effectively integrating eLAFP project deliverables into school learning, these sessions enable participants to gain a better understanding of the eLAFP project deliverables and inspire further innovative teaching approaches.

- **EdTech Solution Showcases**

The showcase will feature over 60 innovative technology solutions, including 22 projects under eLAFP. Participants will have the opportunity to experience pioneering technologies and engage in one-on-one discussions to identify solutions that best meet their school-based needs and teaching goals.

- **eLAFP One-on-one Consultation Clinics**

Participants will receive one-on-one consultations to assist schools in selecting the most suitable solutions from the 22 eLAFP projects based on their school-based needs.
