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### **Quality Education Fund e-Learning Ancillary Facilities Programme — Launching of Project Deliverables and Provision of Sponsorship for Use by Schools (Batch 3)**

#### **Summary**

This circular memorandum informs schools of launching the Batch 3 project deliverables developed under the Quality Education Fund (QEF) e-Learning Ancillary Facilities Programme (eLAFP), and invites all publicly-funded schools<sup>1</sup> to use the deliverable(s) with sponsorship provided by QEF. It should be read in conjunction with the Education Bureau (EDB) Circular Memorandum No. 98/2025 of same heading issued on 30 June 2025 regarding the general background information about eLAFP, procedure to subscribe to the launched deliverables and the arrangement of eLAFP voucher to sponsor schools' subscription.

#### **Background**

2. The implementation of eLAFP is for facilitating the development, enrichment and provision of quality e-learning ancillary facilities that will have positive impact in enhancing e-learning through fostering in-depth collaboration among the school sector, tertiary institutions, educational and professional organisations as well as business sector. Among the 22 funded projects, the first two batches of deliverables have been released in June 2025 and January 2026 respectively for use by schools. With the approval of QEF, the third batch of 12 project deliverables is ready for schools' subscription for use in the 2026/27 school year.

4. Regarding the ‘eLEARN 2.0’, schools can download and use the project deliverable free of charge at the dedicated webpage of EdCity at <https://web.edcity.hk/en/elafp>. Schools may need suitable virtual reality (VR) headsets for using the deliverable. For schools that do not possess VR headsets, applications can also be made through EdCity for loan of equipment.

### Subscription to the deliverables

5. Publicly-funded schools are invited to subscribe to the newly launched deliverables and also the deliverables already launched in the first two batches for use in the 2026/27 school year with the sponsorship provided by QEF. Most projects offer schools with flexible subscription period of one school year or half school year. For schools that plan to start using the deliverables in the first half of the 2026/27 school year, applications for sponsorship should be submitted **on or before 30 September 2026**. For schools that plan to start using the deliverables in the second half of the 2026/27 school year, they may submit the application later when the invitation for subscription to the fourth batch is announced<sup>2</sup>.

6. Similar to the procedures in the previous rounds of application, schools need to submit a brief plan on using the deliverable(s) while they apply online. By the end of the subscription period, sponsored schools will be invited to return a brief evaluation report to

facilitate QEF's review on the effectiveness of the programme. There is no limit to the number of deliverables that each school may subscribe with sponsorship provided by QEF. If the allotted amount has been used up or the balance is insufficient to subscribe to certain deliverable, the school concerned needs to pay the difference following the prevailing procedures/ guidelines for the procurement of e-learning resources<sup>3</sup>. The school's payment will be handled by EdCity.

7. Besides subscribing to the launched deliverables, schools may also apply for free trial of the taster samples offered by a total of 15 projects, inclusive of some that have launched their deliverables and others that are still under development. Schools are welcome to browse the dedicated webpage of EdCity and check the availability of these projects for free trial use.

## **Invitation and Enquiry**

8. To provide opportunities for schools to have better understanding of the eLAFP projects and the subscription procedure, the following events will be organised. Principals and teachers are welcome to participate.

(a) *Learning & Teaching Expo 2026*

To enable schools to have more in-depth understanding of the eLAFP projects, representatives of each project will showcase their deliverables at the 'Learning and Teaching Expo 2026' (LTE) on 25 – 27 June 2026 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. School principals and teachers are welcome to visit the eLAFP booth during the above period. For details about the LTE and free registration, schools may browse the website (<https://ltexpo.org/en>) for more information.



(b) *Sharing sessions*

Professional Development Programmes (PDPs) under 'Digital Education Technological Series', 'Digital Education AI in Education Series' or 'Digital Education Pedagogical Series' will be organised in June and July 2026 to introduce the newly launched deliverables. Teachers from participating schools will share their first-hand experiences in using the deliverables. Schools may refer to the EdCity's webpage (<https://web.edcity.hk/en/elafp/events>) for details.

(c) *Briefing session*

EdCity will organise a briefing session at the LTE to explain the subscription process and tips on activation of students' accounts for easy access of the project
