Summary

2. The 11th LTE is presented by Hong Kong Education City (HKEdCity), organised by Bailey Communications HK Limited and supported by the Education Bureau. It will be held from **9 to 11 December 2020 (Wednesday to Friday)** at Hall 3CDE of the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre.

The LTE sets its theme as “Tomorrow’s Learning Today” and provides a professional platform for school leaders and teachers to discover and discuss the latest developments and trends in learning and teaching, educational resources and technology. The Expo this year will continue to cover a great variety of themes, including the new normal in education during and after the pandemic, digital citizenship and future skills development, artificial intelligence and computational thinking, design thinking, reading and language development, growth mindset and well-being, etc.
