Refinement of Arrangements for Feeder / Nominated Schools

Feeder / nominated schools which have complied with the following requirements are allowed to continue with their existing linkage:

S1 admission arrangements in feeder / nominated schools

- (i) As from the SSPA 2015/2017 cycle, feeder / nominated schools, after the deduction of places for repeaters and DP quota from their total S1 capacity, have to adopt the fixed percentage of 85% / 25% respectively of the remaining S1 places to admit P6 students from their linked primary schools at CA under the SSPA.
- (ii) As from the SSPA 2015/2017 cycle, feeder schools with specific problems (e.g. total number of P6 students less than 85% of S1 places reserved for CA) may reserve either 85% of the remaining S1 places or a smaller number of places sufficient to cover all the eligible P6 students in the linked primary schools.

Fee remission scheme in private feeder primary schools

- (iii) To increase the accessibility to private feeder primary schools, the schools concerned are required to adhere to the following principles for setting up a fee remission scheme for needy students **as from the 2016/17 school year**:
 - (a) Information on the fee remission scheme should be uploaded on school website to enhance transparency; and
 - (b) Schools are encouraged to adopt as far as possible an eligibility benchmark comparable to that of the government financial assistance schemes for needy students.
- (iv) Schools are required to submit a written confirmation of their readiness of setting up the fee remission scheme in the 2016/17 school year to their respective Senior School Development Officers by the end of December 2014 the latest. Failing to set up a fee remission scheme by the time as specified would result in discontinuation of the feeder linkage.

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
