Medium of Instruction for Secondary Schools Sharing Session on Optimising Students' Exposure to English through Non-language Subjects

In the event of a public announcement by the EDB that all schools are to be closed as a result of adverse weather conditions (e.g. tropical cyclone or rainstorm), the sharing session will be postponed until further notice.
