Objective(s)

The course will help participants to (a) be familiar with the English language patterns in KLAs of Technology Education, Arts Education and Physical Education (TAPE); (b) adopt, adapt and design instructional materials to support students' learning of both the subject content and the subject language; (c) understand how to present and explain the subject content in English clearly and systematically; (d) develop competency in refining their teaching pedagogy and resources after trials in the workshops; and (e) observe, discuss and share good examples of teaching TAPE using English, including addressing learner diversity.

The course is designed to improve the teaching and learning of TAPE in English through understanding the patterns of the English language in TAPE.

Remarks	<p>(1) To be considered for completing the course, participants are required to have attended at least 80% of the taught sessions and complete the post-course support;</p> <p>(2) The aim of the course is to enhance the competency of the teachers who have met the “teacher capability” criterion for teaching KLAs of Technology Education, Arts Education and Physical Education in the English medium. As this course is meant to be an in-depth programme catering for the needs of KLAs of Technology Education, Arts Education and Physical Education, priority for admission will be given to teachers who have experience in teaching KLAs of Technology Education, Arts Education and Physical Education in the English medium;</p> <p>(3) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission according to the priority set by the Principal;</p>

(4) Successful applicants will be notified by e-mail by PolyU not later than 14 calendar days before the commencement of the class; and

(5) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather

- a. Course/Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am.
