<b>Objective(s)</b>	The course aims to help teacher participants to develop and enhance their understanding of: 1. the concept and structure of academic English, the role of language in learning Science subjects and the English language features of the science genres; 2. the language requirements of students learning the Science Education KLA in English; 3. the planning, teaching and assessment pedagogies to support their students' development of academic English language and literacy skills while conducting ELA to teach the Science Education KLA within different school contexts in Hong Kong; 4. teaching techniques and strategies in conducting ELA in English for motivating students to learn and achieving relevant learning outcomes; 5. the approaches to developing ELA curriculum resources in English for preparing students to learn in English in higher forms. The e-platform will play a major role in collecting and disseminating good practices of effective teaching of the Science Education KLA using EMI.

**Remarks** (1) To be considered completing the course, participants are required to have attended at least 80% of the taught sessions and complete the post-course support;

(2) The aim of the course is to enhance the competence of non-language teachers who have met the “teacher capability” criterion for teaching in the English medium. Priority for admission will be given to teachers who possess experience in teaching non-language subjects in the English medium;

(3) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission according to the priority set by the Principal;

(4) Successful applicants will be notified by mail by The Education University of Hong Kong before the commencement of the class; and

(5) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather

(a) Course/Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above is issued or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am.

(b) Course/Activity for afternoon session will be resumed when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled at or before 11:30 am. Otherwise, Course / Activity for afternoon session will continue to be cancelled.

(c) Participants will be notified for further arrangement in due course.

Note: The basic requirement for “teacher capability” is Level 3 or above in English Language of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination or Grade C or above in English Language (Syllabus B) of the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE) or Level 3 or above in English Language of the HKCEE from 2007 to 2011 or other recognised qualifications.
