Objective(s)	The Course will help teacher participants achieve the following objectives: (a) Understanding the concept and structure of academic English, and the language features that are specific to the Mathematics Education Key Learning Area (KLA); (b) Understanding the language requirements of students learning the Mathematics Education KLA in English; (c) Enhancing participants' competency in helping students develop academic English language and literacy skills while conducting Extended Learning Activities (ELA) to teach the subject-specific knowledge; (d) Developing teaching techniques and strategies in conducting ELA in English for motivating students to learn and achieving relevant learning outcomes; and (e) Developing ELA curriculum resources in English for preparing students to learn in English in higher forms.

Priority for admission will be given to teachers who meet the "Teacher Capability" criterion but do not have any experience in conducting ELA in English yet;</p> <p>(2) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission;</p> <p>(3) Successful applicants will be notified by The University of Hong Kong before the commencement of the class; and</p> <p>(4) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather</p> <p>(a) Course/Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above is issued or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am.</p> <p>(b) Course/Activity for afternoon session will be resumed when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled at or before 11:30 am.
