Objective(s)	The Course shall help teacher participants achieve the following objectives: a) Developing strategies and pedagogy for enhancing classroom communication by using subject-specific language in English; b) Understanding the concept and structure of academic English and its differences between the language of school and everyday language; c) Developing knowledge of the vocabulary items, terms and language features that are specific to their own Key Learning Areas (KLAs) and the language requirements in assessing students' learning; and d) Understanding, acquiring and deploying teaching strategies and classroom management techniques for learning and teaching the non-language KLAs effectively in English as the medium of instruction, including but not limited to: presenting and explaining subject content clearly and systematically, eliciting students' responses through questioning, giving students opportunities to demonstrate their learning in English, helping students with different language proficiencies and learning abilities in developing subject-specific English proficiency (e.g. speaking about the subject and writing on subject-specific assignments), and giving appropriate feedback to help students improve their learning.

Remarks	<p>1) The aim of the course is to enhance the competence of non-language teachers who have met the “teacher capability” criterion for teaching in the English medium. Priority for admission will be given to teachers who meet the "Teacher Capability" criterion but do not have any experience in conducting ELA in English yet.</p> <p>(2) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission.</p> <p>(3) Successful applicants will be notified by The University of Hong Kong before the commencement of the class.</p> <p>(4) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather (a) Course/Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above is issued or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am. (b) Course/Activity for afternoon session will be resumed when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled at or before 11:30 am. Otherwise, Course / Activity for afternoon session will continue to be cancelled.
