Objective(s) The Learning Circle shall help participants achieve the following objectives: (1) Enhancing the teaching pedagogy of Mathematics Education KLA teachers with

the collaboration between English Language and Mathematics Education KLA teachers within their own schools; (2) Supporting teachers to develop the paradigm and skills required for continuous professional development to meet the changing needs of students which include, among others, equipping teachers with the knowledge and skills in conducting assessment for, as and of learning to feedback on teaching and learning; and (3) Mobilising and networking the participant schools for building professional sharing and support within and across schools.

Programme Description The following topics will be covered: (1) Implications behind content and language integrated learning (CLIL) and a genre-based pedagogy to teaching and learning Mathematics; (2) The role of Mathematics and English Language teachers under a CLIL approach and possible modes of teacher collaboration; (3) Balancing content and language learning in the Mathematics classroom – strategies and practices to apprentice students to “The Language of Mathematics”; (4) Enhancing the teacher’s and students’ communicative competence through CLIL lessons – effective questioning and management of interaction in promoting “Maths Talk”; (5) Reinforcing CLIL through e-learning and other resources in and beyond the classroom; (6) Identifying school-based aims, challenges and strategies through a SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats) analysis: Experience-sharing and goal-setting.

Schools applying for the course must nominate at least two and no more than five teachers to join the class;</p> <p>(3) In sending teachers to attend the course, the school</p> <p>(a) must nominate at least one teacher teaching English Language and another teaching in the Mathematics Education KLA. All teachers nominated must have met the "teacher capability" criterion (please see Note below) for teaching non-language subjects in the English medium and have prior experience in teaching in the English medium;</p> <p>(b) must be committed to completing the school-based support (at least 2 days) which forms part of the programme;</p> <p>(4) Successful applicants will normally be notified by mail not later than 14 calendar days before the commencement of the class;</p> <p>(5) Health Measures</p> <p>(a) To minimise the risk of infection of Coronavirus Disease, participants should wear surgical masks in class. Surgical masks and hand sanitisers will be provided;</p> <p>(b) Body temperature of participants will be taken before entering the venue.
