## Objective(s)

The course aims to help teacher participants to (a) understand the concept and structure of academic English and its differences between the language of school and everyday language; (b) enhance knowledge of language features that are specific to their own KLAs and the language requirements in assessing student's learning; (c) help their students to develop proficiency in subject-specific English, including speaking about the subject and writing on subject-specific assignments (e.g. practical report, facts and description, exposition, procedures, recount, etc); and (d) familiarize with vocabulary items or terms that need special attention in content subject areas (e.g. technical terms, figurative terms, words with multiple meaninigs, words easily confused with other words and acronyms, etc.).

## Programme Description

The course helps teachers to understand, recognize and work with academic English through (a) identifying the patterned ways that academic English is used in schooling; (b) appreciating how academic English is arranged to represent subject content; (c) recognizing the difference between technical, abstract and commonsense vocabulary; (d) understanding how academic English makes connections within and across sentences and paragraphs; (e) developing awareness of how ideas are linked and how English texts are made cohesive; (f) identifying how cause and effect is expressed; (g) identifying how information is organized and how it flows smoothly in a text, which includes the function and construction of active and passive voices; and (h) understanding how various perspectives and possibilities are expressed in English. This Course is a general language course. For a focus on specific subjects, please register for specific-subject courses offered by EDB.
