# Different Types of Primary Schools in Hong Kong

1. Government Primary Schools
2. Aided Primary Schools
3. Direct Subsidy Scheme Primary Schools
4. Private Primary Schools

# Government & Aided Primary Schools

- No school fee will be charged
- Their primary one places are allocated under the **POA System**

# Direct Subsidy Scheme Primary Schools, Private Primary Schools and International Schools

- School fees will be charged
- These schools **do NOT join the POA System**
- Parents need to apply to them direct (i.e. not under the POA System)



# **How to get admitted through the POA System?**

# Eligibility

- To join POA 2025, the applicant child must
- reach the age of 5 years 8 months when he/she is enrolled in P1 in September 2025; (i.e. **born on or before 31 December 2019**);
  - be a Hong Kong resident;
  - NOT be attending any primary school; and
  - have NEVER been allocated a P1 place

# POA School Net

- POA system is net based
- The whole territory is divided into  
36 POA School Nets



# Primary One Admission

2 stages :

- Discretionary Places **(DP)** Admission stage  
(take up about 50% of a school's P1 places)
- Central Allocation **(CA)** stage  
(take up about 50% of a school's P1 places)

# Discretionary Places (DP) Admission Stage

# Discretionary Places Admission Stage

- Parents can apply to **ONE** government or aided school in **ANY DISTRICT** (i.e. any POA school net).
- If more than one application to government or aided school is submitted, all your applications for discretionary place will be forfeited.
- Refer to “Primary School Lists by School Net for Discretionary Places Admission Stage”.

# Discretionary Places

## Type A

- Reserve about 30% of P1 places
- For admission of applicant children with siblings studying or parents working full-time in the school
- All applicant children of this category will be admitted by the school



# Discretionary Places

## Type B

- Reserve about 20% of P1 places
- If the number of applications for discretionary places in Type B received by a school exceeds its quota, the school should admit the applicant children according to the Points System.

# The Points System

1. Parent(s) teaching or working full-time in the kindergarten or secondary section if it is of the same address as the primary school (20 points)
2. Sibling(s) studying in the secondary section if it is of the same address as the primary school (20 points)
3. Parent(s) being a school manager of the primary school (20 points)
4. Parent(s) or sibling(s) being a graduate of the primary school (10 points)
5. First-born child (the eldest child in the family irrespective of sex) (5 points)

(Applicant children may claim only one of the relationships from 1 to 5)

6. Same religious affiliation as the sponsoring body which operates the primary school [See Note] (5 points)
7. Parent(s) being a member of the same organisation which sponsors the operation of the primary school [See Note] (5 points)

(Applicant children may claim only one of the relationships from 6 to 7)

8. Applicant child of the right age (5 years 8 months to 7 years old) (10 points)

[Note: Parents are advised to consult the school direct about the definition of “same religious affiliation”/ “a member of the same organisation” before submitting the application form.]

# Discretionary Places Admission Stage

- Submit paper application form to the school direct from **23 to 27 September 2024** or via the e-POA from **19 to 27 September 2024 (till 11:59 p.m.)**
- Results will be released by schools on **18 November 2024**. Parent can also check results via e-POA on **18 November 2024 (from 10:00 a.m.)**
- Register with allocated school on **20 to 21 November 2024** (*If parents cannot register their child with the school within the specified period and time, they would deemed to have given up the school place allocated.*)

When returning the completed application form or submission of electronic application form, parent is required to bring along / upload via e-POA:

1. Parent's Identity Card, Passport or other identity documents (***only applicable to paper application form***)
2. Copy of applicant child's Birth Certificate / Passport
3. Copy of valid proof of residential address (e.g. stamped tenancy agreement, water/ electricity/ town gas / residential telephone bills)
4. Copy of the Birth Certificate and school handbook of the applicant child's sibling, if claiming the applicant child's sibling is studying in the school or the secondary section of the school of the same address applied for



**When returning the completed application form or submission of electronic application form, parent is required to bring along / upload via e-POA:**

5. Copy of the Birth Certificate of the applicant child's sibling and graduate certificate of the applicant child's sibling / parent, if claiming the applicant child's sibling or parent's graduate relationship
6. Copy of the Baptism Certificate of the applicant child, if claiming the applicant child's same religious affiliation relationship with the school
7. Copy of the parent's membership document, if the parent claims that he / she is a member of the same organisation which sponsors the operation of the primary school

# Application through e-POA



# e-POA

- In line with the “Smart Government” strategy, the EDB has fully implemented digitalisation of POA. Parents / Guardians can submit applications for discretionary places and central allocation, as well as check results of allocation of discretionary places and central allocation via ePOA. (URL: <https://epoa.edb.gov.hk/login?lang=en> or scan the QR code at the bottom)





# e-POA

- Parents should NOT submit duplicate applications via ePOA and in paper form for the same child and are allowed to apply for a discretionary place of only ONE government or aided primary school in any POA School Net for each applicant child . Irrespective of whether the application is submitted via ePOA or in paper form, if parents have applied to more than one government or aided primary school, their applications for discretionary place will be rendered void.

# e-POA

- If parents wish to use the above electronic services, they have to register their ePOA accounts via the “iAM Smart” mobile app (URL: <https://www.iamsmart.gov.hk/en> or scan the QR code at the bottom). Parents who have bound their accounts to “iAM Smart+” can submit primary one applications and check the results of allocation of discretionary places and central allocation through e-Platform. Parents who have bound their accounts to “iAM Smart” can check the results through the e-Platform.

# Central Allocation (CA) Stage



# Central Allocation Stage

- Applicant children who have not been offered a discretionary place will participate in the Central Allocation.
- A **fresh application** for the Central Allocation is **NOT necessary**.
- Each primary school earmarks about 50% of its P1 places for Central Allocation.

# Choices of Schools

## Part A – Unrestricted School Choices

- Can choose **ANY school** located in **ANY school net**
- About 10% of P1 places are earmarked for unrestricted school choices (i.e. Part A in Central Allocation).
- Parents may make up to 3 choices of schools from any school nets (including the home net).

# Choices of Schools

## Part B – Restricted School Choices

- About 90% of P1 places are earmarked for restricted school choices (i.e. Part B in Central Allocation)
- Parents should **select schools available in the applicant children's residing school net** to avoid travelling unreasonably long distances to attend schools.

# Choices of Schools

- When choosing a primary school for your children, parents should first identify children's characteristics, personalities, abilities and interests, and then consider various factors such as the sponsoring body, history, location and religion of a school.



# Computer Processing of Central Allocation

- To ensure fairness, allocation results are based on parental choices and random numbers of applicant children.
- First process the unrestricted school choices (Part A)
- Then process the restricted school choices (Part B)



# Central Allocation Stage

- Parents will be informed in **early Jan 2025** by EDB in writing to make school choices via e-POA or at designated Central Allocation centres on the specified dates.
- Parents should make school choices from **13 to 19 January 2025 (till 11:59 p.m.)** via e-POA or go to the specified Central Allocation centre to make their choices of schools **on 18 or 19 January 2025**.
- If parents have not received the letter **by 13 January 2025**, they should contact the School Places Allocation Section.

# Central Allocation Stage

- Allocation processed centrally by computer
- Results of Central Allocation to be sent to parents **by post and SMS** on **4 to 5 June 2025**. Parents can also check results via e-POA on **4 June 2025 (from 10:00 a.m.)**
- Registration of Primary 1 pupils allocated with places through Central Allocation on **10 to 11 June 2025**

# Central Allocation Stage

- EDB will arrange to deliver the 'Primary One Registration Form' with the result of Central Allocation by post to parents' correspondence address provided in the POA application form from 4 to 5 June 2025 through the 'Local CourierPost' service provided by Hongkong Post. The letter will be delivered to door.
- If attempt of door delivery by Hongkong Post fails, a 'Mail Collection Notification Card' will be left for parents to collect it from the designated post office starting from the afternoon of the following working day.

# Central Allocation Stage

- If parents have not received the 'Primary One Registration Form' or the 'Mail Collection Notification Card' issued by Hongkong Post, they could collect the 'Primary One Registration Form' at the designated 'Collection Centre' from 7 to 8 June 2025 (For the latest arrangements, please refer to EDB Primary One Admission Website).



# Central Allocation Stage

- Apart from issuing the 'Primary One Registration Form' by post, if parents wish to receive the results of the CA for POA 2025 of their applicant children via SMS message on 4 June 2025, they may provide a mobile number which can receive SMS message on the Choice of Schools Form / e-POA and indicate their consent to receive the results of the CA via this mobile phone number.

- The EDB will assign timeslots for parents to register with the allocated school **on 10 or 11 June 2025.**

# Education support for non-Chinese speaking (NCS) students

# The Government

- is committed to encouraging and supporting the integration of NCS students into the community (i.e. early adaptation to the local education system and mastery of the Chinese language).
- ensures NCS children enjoy equal opportunities for admission to public sector schools and learning of Chinese on par with their Chinese-speaking counterparts.

# The Education Bureau (EDB)

- has substantially increased the additional funding for schools.
- has provided schools with teaching resources, teacher training and professional support to further enhance the support for NCS students' learning of the Chinese language.

- implementation of the “Chinese Language Curriculum Second Language Learning Framework” in schools
  - drawn up in consultation with teachers and language experts
  - to help NCS students learn Chinese
- creation of an inclusive learning environment in schools



- Parents of NCS applicant children are encouraged to choose schools with an immersed Chinese language environment to help the applicant children learn the Chinese language.
- Most of the public sector schools including the list of schools in the applicant children's residing school nets have an immersed Chinese language environment.

# Having due regard to the aforementioned, in case parents

- consider that the applicant children may still have difficulties studying in a school with an immersed Chinese language environment at this stage, and
- indicate on the application form that the applicant children cannot use Chinese as the learning medium
