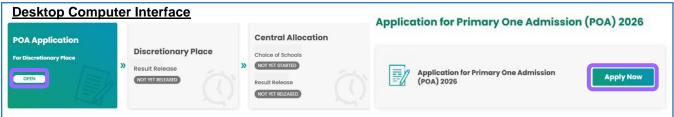
Points to Note

- (1) To efficiently handle a large number of applications, each login to POA e-Platform (ePOA) is limited to 30 minutes. Please complete the application procedures within 30 minutes. If necessary, parents may use the "Save as draft" function and continue with the application concerned at the next login.
- (2) For parents with more than one child participating in the POA in the same year, they may use the same account bound to "iAM Smart+" to submit applications for discretionary places (DP) and check the relevant results.
- (3) Irrespective of whether the application is submitted in paper form or through the ePOA, if parents have submitted applications to more than one government or aided primary school for the same applicant child, the application for a DP of the applicant child would be rendered void.
- (4) The network may be busy and congested on the dates / periods close to the online application deadline; and parents should reserve sufficient time to avoid delays in application.
- (5) If the school notices that the information filled or the documents submitted by the parent concerned are incorrect or incomplete, the school will "unlock" the application to let the parent rectify the information or re-submit the documents. The computer system will automatically send an email to notify the parent concerned for his/her follow-up actions.
- (6) Parents must ensure that after digital signing using iAM Smart, they return to ePOA and click "Confirm and Submit" button in order to complete the application. After completing the application, they will receive an email issued by EDB confirming the submission of the application (this is different from the email issued by "iAM Smart" confirming the digital signing).

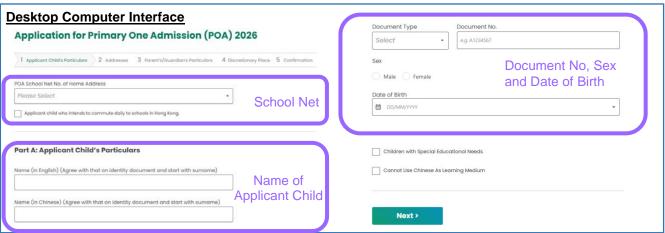
Steps for Submitting DP Applications (Using "iAM Smart+")

2 Input Applicant Child's Particulars

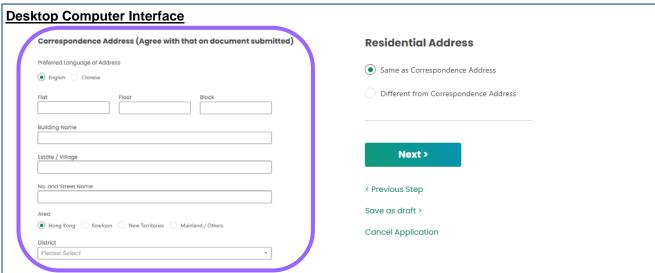

Upload Supporting Documents

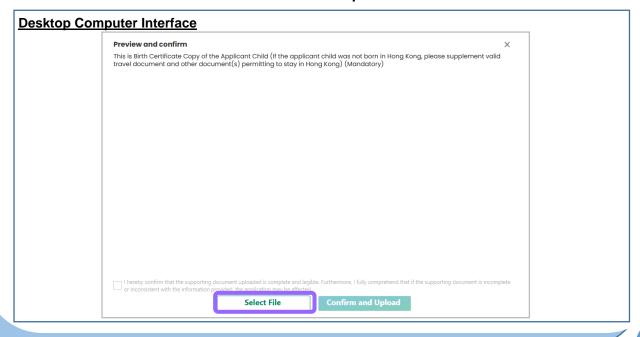
- Parents should upload the copies of applicant child's identity document and proof of residential address (mandatory).

- Please note that only image files (GIF BMP PNG JPEG) and PDF files are accepted. Maximum size of total files uploaded is 20 MB.
- Click "Next" after uploading all supporting documents.

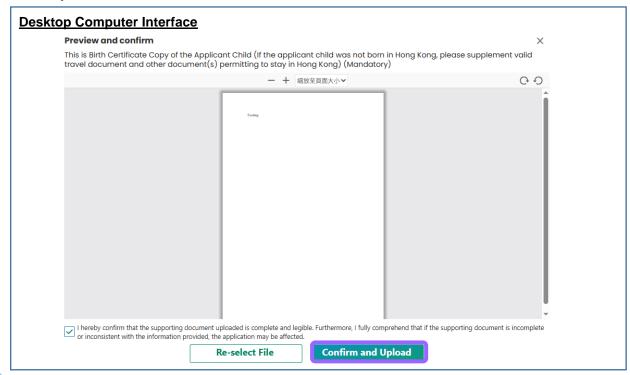

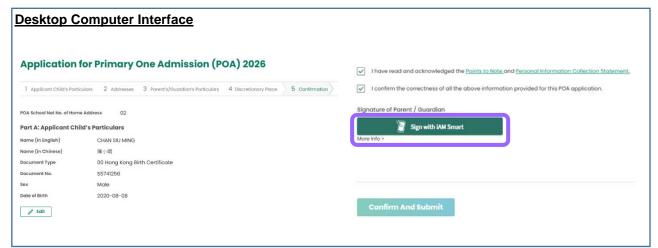

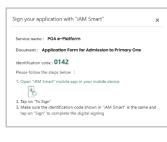

 The System pops up a message box about digital signature. After confirmation, the System will remind parents to open the "iAM Smart" App in the mobile phone.





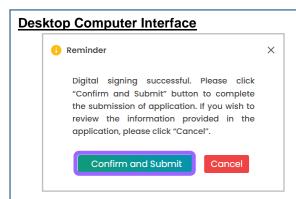

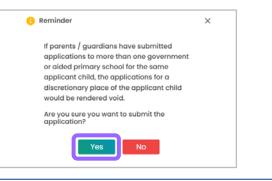
 Open the "iAM Smart" App in the mobile phone, then click "Sign" to proceed.



Confirm and Submit the Application

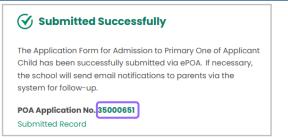
- The System reminds the parent that the application is signed successfully, then click "Confirm and Submit" to submit the application.

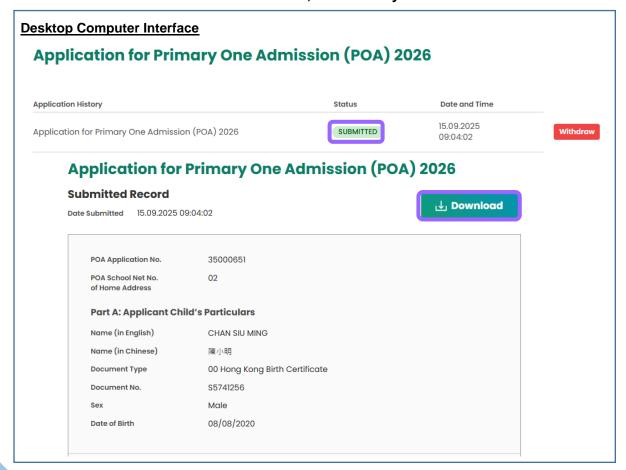
