Education Support for Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) Students

Key Message

• The Government is committed to encouraging and supporting the integration of NCS students into the community, including facilitating their early adaptation to the local education system and mastery of the Chinese language

Key Message

- Policy intent: encourage parents of NCS students to arrange for their children to study in schools with an immersed Chinese language environment as early as possible to facilitate their mastery of the Chinese language
- The Government provides NCS students with allencompassing learning support through diverse strategies to help them master the Chinese language and integrate into the community

1. Chinese Language Curriculum Second Language Learning Framework ("Learning Framework")

- Provides steps and methods for learning and teaching, and assessment according to the needs of NCS students of learning Chinese as a second language
- The "Learning Framework", complemented by learning and teaching materials, helps NCS students learn Chinese progressively

2. Provision of learning and teaching resources

- Learning and teaching resources are uploaded to the webpage of the Education Bureau and updated on an ongoing basis
 - > e.g. a set of learning and teaching materials
 - student textbooks, workbooks and teaching reference materials
 - suitable for P1-6 NCS students

Provision of learning and teaching resources

- Online Chinese Language self-learning resources
 - >to provide diversified learning materials to help NCS students extend learning beyond the classroom and consolidate their learning



3. Teacher training and professional support to schools

- Professional development programmes
 - all Chinese Language teachers teaching NCS students are provided with training opportunities
 - > structured and diversified modes of teacher professional development programmes

Teacher training and professional support to schools

- Diversified school-based support services
 - > e.g. help schools adapt their school curriculum and develop appropriate learning and teaching materials

4. Additional funding support to schools

 Provides an additional funding for all public sector schools (including special schools) and Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) schools offering the local curriculum and admitting NCS students

Additional funding support to schools

Overall use of funding by schools

- Mainly used for employing/deploying additional Chinese Language teachers and teaching assistants to implement diversified modes of learning and teaching
- Also used for appointing assistants of different races and/or procurement of professional services to strengthen communication with parents of NCS students, organising activities to promote cultural integration, etc.

Additional funding support to schools

- Most of the schools assigned middle management to coordinate Chinese learning and teaching for NCS students as well as the planning and deployment of school resources and manpower
- Many schools have set up a coordinating team with teachers in relevant discipline, including the Chinese Language teachers, to participate in planning and deploying the school-based support measures

Additional funding support to schools

- Progress has been made:
 - enhancing teachers' professional capability for teaching NCS students Chinese
 - deploying more resources to develop school-based teaching resources and curricula, and adopt diversified teaching strategies and activities
 - > enhancing NCS students' motivation, confidence and performance in learning
- Many parents of the NCS students were satisfied with the support provided to their children in learning Chinese by schools

The enhanced support measures have widened school choices of parents of NCS students

• In the 2024/25 school year, there were about 710 primary and secondary schools admitting NCS students, which covered about 75% of the schools in total

Key Message

•With appropriate support, NCS students can master the Chinese language

5. Other Complementary Measures for NCS Students and Their Parents

- Summer Bridging Programme
 - >organised for NCS students progressing to Primary 1 to 6
 - parents of participating NCS students are also invited to join the Programme


Other Complementary Measures for NCS Students and Their Parents

• Diversified parent education programmes for parents of NCS students to help them support their children's learning and encourage their children to master the Chinese language

Other Complementary Measures for NCS Students and Their Parents

- Parent Education Resource Booklet for Parents of NCS Students
 - To equip parents of NCS students to support the learning and whole-person development of their children
 - Translated into languages of diverse races
