1. To be eligible for allocation of a Secondary One (S1) place, your child (the student applicant) must be Hong Kong resident / Hong Kong permanent resident, has completed primary education by end of August 2025, has never been allocated a S1 place through the Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) System, has never made any applications to the School Places Allocation (SPA) Section of the Education Bureau (EDB) before, and has never studied in any public sector secondary schools (including government, aided, and caput secondary schools) and Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) secondary schools in Hong Kong.  
 (Note: If a student applicant has been allocated a S1 place for the 2025/26 school year, the applicant will not be eligible for participating in the SSPA in future.)
  
2. EDB will verify the student applicant's eligibility for receiving education in public sector schools in Hong Kong. EDB may need to approach the Immigration Department to verify his / her eligibility for receiving education in public sector schools in Hong Kong before arranging a school place for him / her. The application for S1 admission **will not** be processed if the information provided by the Immigration Department reveals that the student applicant is not eligible for receiving education in public sector schools in Hong Kong.
  
3. If there are no public sector secondary school places available in the student applicant's residential district, EDB will consider the order of preference of other districts as stipulated in the application form to place the student applicant in a public sector secondary school in other districts. Whether the student applicant allocated to a public sector secondary school in a nearby district depends on the availability of S1 places in the school in the district(s) concerned.

6. Parents / guardians / authorised persons can opt for receiving the Allocation Slip and Admission Slip (A/A Slips) by post or collecting the A/A Slips in person at the SPA Section. For those opted to receive the A/A Slips by post, the Slips will be mailed to the local residential address or the local postal address (if applicable) provided in the application form. If parents / guardians / authorised persons have not provided a local residential address and local postal address, they have to collect the A/A Slips at the SPA Section. Those who do not receive the A/A Slips by post should contact the SPA Section or visit the SPA Section's office on the following working day.
7. Parents / guardians / authorised persons may view the allocation results via the following means:
  - (i) via SMS: If the parents / guardians / authorised persons have provided a mobile phone number for receiving allocation results via SMS message, a confirmation SMS stating your application number and the date of announcement of results will be issued by EDB before the date of announcement of results.   - (ii) via SSPA e-Platform: Parents / guardians / authorised person who have registered as SSPA e-Platform users with "iAM Smart" or "iAM Smart+"<sup>1</sup> may view the allocation results via the SSPA e-Platform starting from 10 a.m. on the date of announcement of results. 8. For applications made on or after 11 August 2025, parents / guardians / authorised persons will be informed of the collection of A/A Slips in writing / by telephone / in person before 29 August 2025 (i.e. before the commencement of the new school year).
9. While waiting for the result of the application, the student applicant may still apply to any schools direct for a S1 place. Should the student applicant receive an offer from a school, the parent / guardian / authorised person should inform the SPA Section immediately via the school by filling in "Allocation Slip and Admission Slip Application Form" so as to confirm the admission of the student applicant to the school concerned and cancel the student applicant's previous application to EDB for a S1 place. (Note: The school concerned will collect on your behalf the A/A Slips. The school will keep the Admission Slip and return the Allocation Slip to the applicant.) **Should EDB receive the "Allocation Slip and Admission Slip Application Form" submitted by the parent / guardian / authorised person via the school which indicates that the student applicant has been admitted by the school, the student applicant's previous application to EDB for a S1 place will not be processed.**
10. If you wish to make any amendments to the personal information of the student applicant you have provided in the Application Form (e.g. amend student applicant's name so as to align with that shown on the renewed identity document) after submission, you should inform the SPA Section at least five working days prior to the date of collection of the A/A Slips for the timely update. As for amendments of other information in the application form, please ensure all changes are completed by the application deadline. Any requests to amend information in the application form or to cancel the application after the deadline will not be processed.

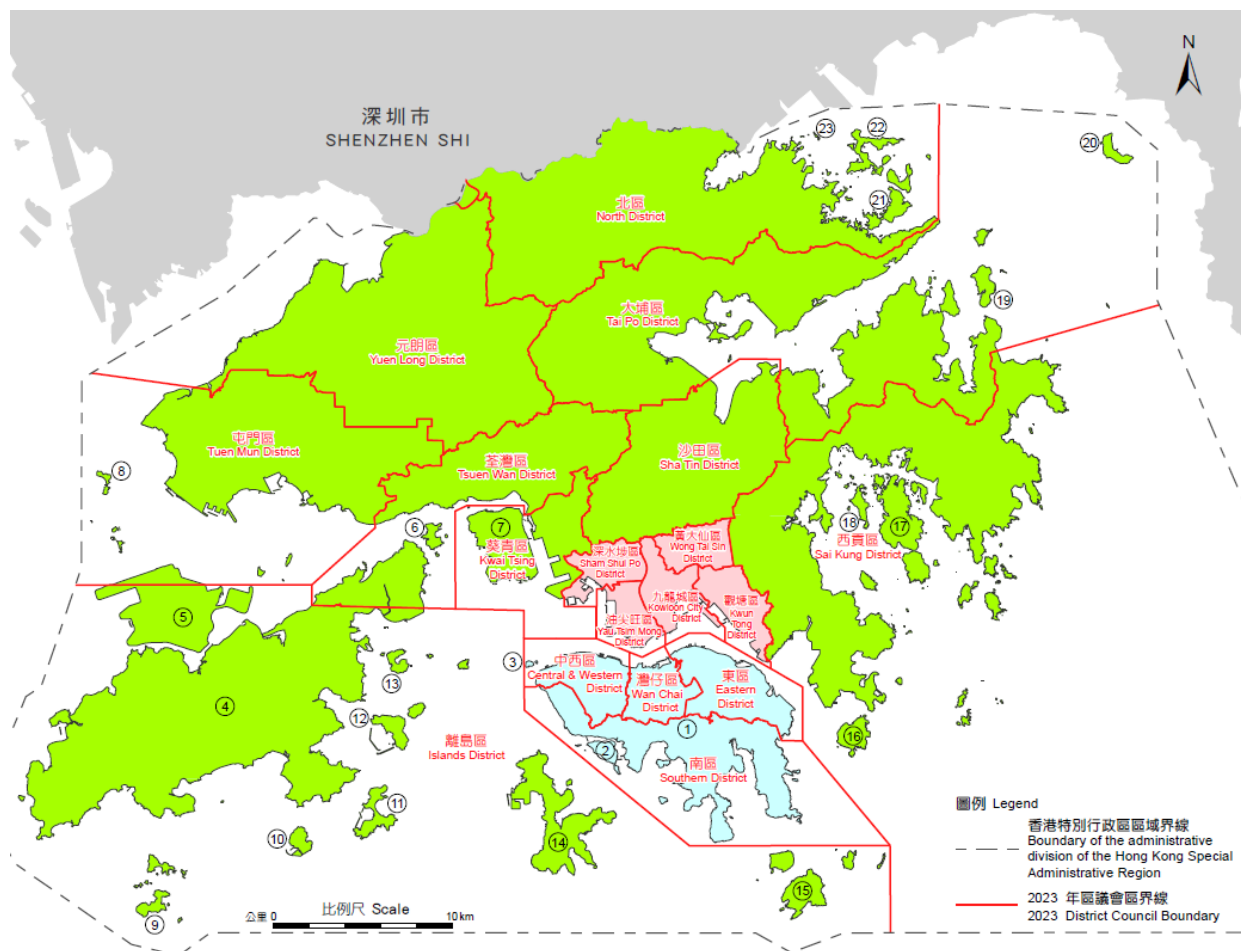
