Synopsis 故事大綱:

Years ago, when the final school bell rang, students would celebrate. 'After School' meant a chance to play. But too often today, 'After School' means the busy day is about to get busier. Alternatively, 'After School' means attending classes in tutorial centres, where students spend extended hours past dinner time to complete tasks assigned by the centres, not including the assignments from school. For those who could go straight home 'After School', they might return to an empty flat, without any parents or guardians present until the late hours of the evening.

The students in this play have to face their greatest struggle yet: being sent to detention. They fear not the consequence of a detention on their records, but missing out on their commitments 'After School'. Without a chance to leave campus, the students have to deal with their pains and their fears head-on.

Come and discover how our students can overcome the pressures of life 'After School'.



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SCENE 1: THE CLASSROOMS

Three separate classes are having the end of their lessons. The teacher in each class keeps teaching but doesn't notice that the students are not paying attention. In each classroom, the students are falling asleep or are too tired or are too worried about something else

Teacher 1 (Andrew)	27 plus 36! You add the last numbers. 7 plus 5 is 12, so you carry the 1, and what do you get?	
Teacher 2 (Matthew Au)	The present perfect tense is made of the ver 'be' and the pp, or past participle. So, what is the present perfect for 'we go'?	
Teacher 3 (Ryan)	Plants take in carbon dioxide and they give out oxygen. We learnt this before. What is this called?	
Suddenly, the teachers see the students are not paying attention.

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SCENE 2: THE WALK TO DETENTION

As the groups of students walk to their detention, we see them walking in fear as they imagine the characters of their own scenarios whom they are worried about. These characters appear 'offstage'. As the characters speak, the students grow more and more worried.
