Prologue

Enter Bottom.

During the later part of the speech, Chorus enter and freeze in different poses.

Bottom: If we offend, it is with our good will. That you should think we come not to offend, But with good will. To show our simple skill, That is the true beginning of our end. Consider then we come but in despite. We do not come as minding to contest you, Our true intent is. All for your delight We are not here. That you should here repent you, The actors are at hand, and by their show You shall know all that you are like to know.

Life's a Happy Song from The Muppets

Enter Theseus and Hippolyta, outrageously in love.

Bottom:	Now, Theseus and Hippolyta are having a wedding in four days		
Theseus:	Everything is great Everything is grand I got the whole wide world in the palm of my hand		
Hippolyta:	Everything is perfect It's falling into place I can't seem to wipe this smile off my face		
Both:	Life's a happy song, when there's someone by my side to sing along		
Theseus:	Four happy days bring in another moon. But oh, methinks how slow this old moon wanes!		
Hippolyta:	Four days will quickly steep themselves in night. Four nights will quickly dream away the time.		

Enter the four lovers.

- Egeus: But...

Bottom: Off you go now, bye.

Exit Egeus.

Egues:

All unfreeze and exit in annoyance, except the lovers.

Bottom: (to audience) I'll make it brief.

Chopsticks

Hermia is in love with Lysander. Lysander is in love with Hermia. But Hermia is engaged with Demetrius, who loves her too. And Hermia's best friend, Helena, is in love with Demetrius, But frankly, Demetrius wants nothing to do with her. So, Hermia and Lysander decided to run away to the forest together. It was meant to be a secret, but they told Helena anyway...

Exit Hermia and Lysander.

Which means goodbye *FOREVER*! But then she thought it would be a good idea to tell Demetrius So that he would chase after Hermia into the woods And of course, she followed him.

Exit Demetrius, followed by Helena.

Music change.

Enter Chorus, turning the stage into a forest setting.

Bottom: Now, this is when things REALLY begin. We are now in the forest And will soon meet Oberon, the Fairy King And his beautiful queen, Titania. I'd better get ready for my part, For I will play the very important role of... (gibberish)

Before Bottom finishes his speech, Chorus puts a donkey's head onto Bottom. Exit Bottom with much difficulty getting his way around.

Scene 1

Oberon, the Fairy King, and his followers enter. On the opposite side of the stage, Titania, the Fairy Queen, and her followers enter.

Oberon:	How not nice to see you, proud Titania.
Titania:	What, jealous Oberon? – Fairies, let's get out of here. I am sick of seeing his face, or talking to him.
Oberon:	Wait a minute. Aren't you supposed to obey me, your lord and husband?
Titania:	If you're my lord and husband, I must be your lady and wife, so you're supposed to be faithful to me.
Oberon:	Oh, why should Titania cross her Oberon? I do but beg a little changeling boy, To be my henchman.
Titania:	Set your heart at rest. I won't give up this child for all of Fairyland. Come, fairies, I can't stay here any longer!

Exit Titania and her fairies.

Oberon:	PUCK!
Enter Puck.	

Oberon: My dear Puck, I want you to help me look for a flower on which Cupid's arrow fell. Young girls called it "love-in-idleness". If its juice is put on someone's eyelids while they're asleep, that person will fall in love with the next living creature he or she sees. I want that plant, be as quick as you can.

Puck: Yes, King Oberon.

Exit Puck.

Helena: Demetrius! Demetrius, I love you! I love you! I love you!

Demetrius: *(from off)* Look, I don't love you, so follow me no more.

Oberon hides.

Enter Demetrius, followed by Helena.
