Market Commentaries

- The US Federal Reserve held interest rates steady. Market generally opined that major central banks had reached the end of their interest rate hiking cycles.
- The US 10-year Government bond yield increased from around 4.1% by the end of August 2023 to around 4.3% by the end of November 2023.
- During the quarter ended 30 November 2023, the Hang Seng Index decreased by about 7.3% from 18,382 as at the end of August 2023 to 17,042 by the end of November 2023, and the Dow Jones Industrial Average Index increased by about 3.5% from 34,721 to 35,950 during the same period.
