**COVID-19 Vaccination Programme
Expansion of Same-day Ticket Arrangements
to Students Aged 12 or Above**

Starting from 27 August, same-day tickets will be distributed to eligible students at 24 Community Vaccination Centres (CVCs) (except those run by private hospitals) under the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme. The minimum age for receiving the BioNTech vaccine is 12, and that for receiving the Sinovac vaccine is 18. We cordially invite all post-secondary institutions, secondary and primary schools to appeal to students, teachers and parents to receive vaccination as soon as possible. Apart from applying group booking and outreach service under COVID-19 Vaccination Programme and making individual booking via the programme website, students can also make good use of the same-day ticket arrangement.

Same-day Ticket Arrangements

On 29 July, the same-day ticket arrangement was first introduced for persons aged 70 or above and was later extended to cover persons aged 60 or above to receive vaccination at a designated timeslot on the day of distribution. The arrangement has been implemented smoothly since its launch. After

evaluating the actual situation, we have decided to extend the arrangement to cover students of all post-secondary institutions, secondary and primary schools. Taken into account that some students may need the company of their teachers or parents, each student getting the same-day ticket at CVCs can be accompanied by a maximum of two persons. The companions can also receive vaccination together. When receiving the first dose of vaccination, persons to be vaccinated will be informed of the date and time for the second dose.

Distribution Timeslot & Daily Quota

The same-day tickets will be distributed daily from 7:45am on a first-come, first-served basis. The locations of the 24 CVCs which distribute the same-day tickets are listed in the Annex. The daily quota for each CVC (except those run by private hospitals) is 200 while that of Tung Chung Community Hall CVC and Hong Kong International Airport CVC is 100 each. The CVCs open from 8:00am and close at 8:00pm daily. The CVCs are closed between 1:30pm and 2:30pm daily for cleaning and disinfection and the last session of vaccination is held from 7:00pm to 7:30pm daily.

Required Documents

Students can present their identity documents and school attendance documents (e.g. student card, school library card, school handbook, etc) to get a same-day ticket at CVCs. They can also authorise their family members or carers to get a ticket on their behalf, provided that the authorised person can present a copy of the relevant identity documents and school attendance documents.

Adolescents aged 12 to 17 are required to bring along the completed Consent Form signed by their parents/guardian to the CVCs for getting their vaccinations. The consent form can be downloaded from the designated website of the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme (www.covidvaccine.gov.hk). Limited copies of consent form will be available at CVCs for persons in need.
