

Calculation of Capacity Enhancement Grant (CEG)

CEG will be released to schools in accordance with a schedule of rates, which will be adjusted by the movement of the Composite Consumer Price Index (CCPI) annually.

In addition, schools are also requested to note the following:

1. For an aided bi-sessional primary school with a total of 25 ordinary classes or more, each session is considered as a separate school for the calculation of CEG.
2. For an ordinary school with both primary and secondary sections/classes, the rates for primary schools will be adopted, and the number of eligible classes will be the total number of approved primary and secondary classes.
3. For Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) schools, the amount of the grant will be calculated according to the approved formula.
4. Caput schools and schools operating full-time Initiation Programme for newly arrived children (IP schools for NAC) will receive the same rates of CEG as aided and government schools.
