- * From the 2026/27 s.y. onwards, the Boarding Grant and Top-up Boarding Grant will be consolidated and renamed as the Special School Boarding Grant. The grant calculation mechanism will remain the same after consolidation. Besides, the level of Boarding Grant for Special Schools per boarder per month should deduct the boarding fee per boarder per month. In the 2026/27 s.y., the rates of the monthly boarding fee are \$440 and \$616 for 5-day boarder and 7-day boarder respectively.
- @ From the 2026/27 s.y. onwards, the Resource Material Grant for Visually Impaired Students and Travelling Grant for Resource Teachers will be consolidated and renamed as the Grant for Resource Support Programme (RSP) for Visually Impaired Students. The grant calculation mechanism will remain the same after consolidation.
- % In the 2025/26 s.y., additional incentive funding of \$800 per senior secondary (SS) class per year is provided for schools with a utilisation rate of the Diversity Learning Grant (Other Programmes) of 80% or above, based on the schools' annual accounts of the most recent year (i.e. a total of \$7,800 per SS class per year). The incentive funding will cease with effect from 2026/27.
- ▲ Since schools were required to submit applications for "Home-School Co-operation Grants" in the 2025/26 s.y., the approved subsidy amount for each school was different.
- ^ Intensive Support Grant for Special Schools is provided to approved special schools on a case-by-case basis.
