**Install the revamped
E-platform for School Development and Accountability
for using the revised school self-evaluation tools**

The Education Bureau (EDB) issued the EDB Circular No. 15/2022 on 11 November 2022 to inform schools of the implementation details about the enhanced School Development and Accountability (SDA) framework, including starting from the 2023/24 school year, schools will be required to annually collect the Key Performance Measures (KPM) data to conduct school self-evaluation (SSE). For those schools at the end of their school development cycle in this school year (i.e. the 2022/23 school year), they should continue the existing practice of submitting the data of revised KPM, including the relevant data of the Stakeholder Survey (SHS) and Assessment Program for Affective and Social Outcomes (APASO), to the EDB. Schools should install the revamped E-platform for School Development and Accountability (ESDA) at the earliest convenience to obtain the revised SSE tools, especially for those schools at the end of their school development cycle this school year.

The EDB informed schools about the launch of the revamped ESDA and the related installation and data migration issues on 10 August 2022. The demonstration video clips on the installation of the revamped ESDA have also been uploaded to the EDB webpage (<https://www.edb.gov.hk/en/sch-admin/sch-quality-assurance/performance-indicators/esda/self-learning.html>) for school personnel's reference. The EDB recommends schools to try using the original hardware to install the revamped ESDA and obtain the revised SSE tools after completing the collection and management of the SSE data of the previous school year.

Schools are suggested to conduct SSE by using the revised SSE tools starting from this school year, so as to be more focused on the seven learning goals.
