

Enrolling in local ordinary schools

Education services for students with learning difficulties



Children entering Primary 1 may show variation in their development that affects their learning and adjustment. To identify and support these children at an early stage, government, aided and Direct Subsidy Scheme schools annually conduct the 'Early Identification and Intervention of Learning Difficulties Programme for Primary One Pupils'.

For those students who seem to experience learning difficulties, teachers will complete an observation checklist for them during early December to early January to identify those with mild and marked learning difficulties. Then appropriate support measures can be arranged as early as possible.

Many of these students show only mild learning difficulties. If parents could collaborate with teachers at an early stage, these mild learning difficulties are more likely to be overcome or mitigated.
