**School-Based Support Scheme Grant for
Schools with Intake of Newly Arrived Children (NAC)**

Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to invite schools with intake of children newly arrived from the Mainland, non-Chinese speaking (NCS) children newly joining the local education system and returnee children to apply for the School-Based Support Scheme Grant (the Grant).

Details

2. Schools should use the Grant to flexibly provide support services for meeting the learning and adaptation needs of the children mentioned above. EDB Circular Memorandum No. 134/2022 dated 9 August 2022 announced that the rate of the Grant per pupil per annum has been adjusted from \$3,931 to \$4,002 at primary level and from \$5,827 to \$5,932 at secondary level for the 2022/23 school year.

3. In order to streamline the administration procedures for the application of the Grant, schools are required to make application for the Grant only once in each school year. Schools are invited to:

- (a) apply for the Grant in respect of the actual number of students who are children newly arrived from the Mainland, NCS children newly joining the local education system and returnee children admitted during the period from 1 September 2021 to 31 August 2022, both dates inclusive; and
- (b) apply for advance payment of the Grant for the 2022/23 school year, with reference to the number of NAC as stated in paragraph (a) above.

4. For advance payment, adjustment on the basis of the number of NAC admitted

for the 2022/23 school year will be made in the next round (i.e. 2023/24 school year) of application. Schools that do not apply for advance payment of the Grant now may apply for the Grant in the 2023/24 school year based on the actual number of such children admitted in the 2022/23 school year.

6. Schools must ensure that the criteria and requirements are satisfied when applying for and using the Grant. Applications for the respective purposes, together with copies of the required documents, should be sent **on or before 6 October 2022** by post or by hand to the Newly Arrived Children Support Unit of the Education Bureau at Room 1424, 14/F, Wu Chung House, 213 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong.
