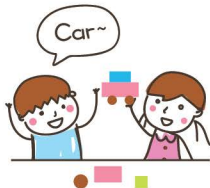


Types of Play

Constructive play

Children use small parts like blocks and clay to build things that others can recognize.



Pretend play
