Tips for parents



let children choose games that allow creativity or that are interactive



avoid too much guidance or help, let children take the lead



respond to children's needs in a timely manner



focus on playing with children, pay attention to children's verbal and nonverbal expressions



provide concrete and timely praise to children's positive behaviours



point out children's inappropriate behaviours and correct them immediately, help children express their emotion in an appropriate way



act as a role model
