**Objective(s)** The course will help participants to (a) be familiar with the English language patterns in PSHE; (b) understand how to develop students' abstract and technical PSHE vocabulary; (c) understand how to develop students' understanding of how to express causality and uncertainty, and how to organize their texts (spoken, written and visual) so the meanings are clear; (d) develop competency in refining their teaching pedagogy and resources after trials in the workshops; and (e) observe, discuss and share good examples of teaching PSHE using English, including addressing learner diversity.

**Programme Description** The course is designed to improve the teaching and learning of PSHE KLA in English through understanding the patterns of the English language in PSHE KLA.

<b>Remarks</b>	(1) To be considered for completing the course, participants are required to have attended at least 80% of the taught sessions and have completed the post-course support;  (2) The aim of the course is to enhance the competence of the PSHE KLA teachers who have met the “teacher capability” criterion for teaching in the English medium. As this course is meant to be an in-depth programme catering for the needs of the PSHE KLA, priority for admission will be given to teachers who possess experience in teaching the PSHE KLA in

the English medium;

(3) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission according to the priority set by the Principal;

(4) Successful applicants will be notified by mail by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University not later than 14 calendar days before the commencement of the class; and

(5) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather

(a) Course/Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am.

(b) Course/Activity for afternoon session will be resumed when Typhoon Signal No.8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled at or before 11:30 am. Otherwise, Course / Activity for afternoon session will continue to be cancelled.
