

## Home-School Communication Approach - Information Technology for Parent and Child (Primary)

### Characteristics of the Approach

#### 1. Features of the Approach

- To teach parents how to use a computer and log on to the school web site, so as to establish and maintain a tight communication network between school, parents, and children. A Parent Homepage is built for enhancing parent-teacher and parent-parent communication and network building. Through the tight communication network, the stakeholders understand that information technology (IT) can provide students, parents and teachers with the tools and training to support students' achievement of essential learning outcomes according to their individual abilities.
- To establish a student's personal profiling system that allows the monitoring of ongoing individual work online and provides feedback to the student, teacher and parents.
- To provide avenues for parents to be involved in their child's learning.

#### 2. Facilitating Factors

- Evening and weekend computer classes and information sessions for parents have been very well attended;
- Parents are able to connect via the Internet to participate in the teacher-designed activities and to monitor their own child's individual work as well as their progress on-line on a day-to-day basis.
- Activities and good web sites are recommended in the Parent HomePage for the parents and their child to learn together at home.

## Impact

- When parents work together with their child on teacher designed activities via the web they gain valuable insights into their child's potential to learn as well as being informed about what their child is learning at school at any point in time.
- Students share valuable time together with their parents, who help them complete school-work and other online activities.
- Both students and parents are also able to communicate directly with the teacher using email.
- The key strength of this approach is that teachers are able to closely monitor individual students' progress and be in direct contact with students and parents. This type of communication proves effective yet private, as only the participants can see the messages and their content.
- When this approach is introduced into the mainstream, parents no longer have to wait till they receive a formal report from school. Instead, they are in constant contact with the teachers, either on a regular basis or from time to time as needed.
