I. Written range and open strings for Strings (弦樂)

- Violin
- Viola
- Cello
- Double bass

Other string techniques:

- Arco
- Pizzicato (*pizz.*)
- Up bow
- Down bow
- Bartók pizz.
- Pizzicato with multiple stops

II. Written range and characteristics for Woodwind (木管樂)

- Flute
- Oboe
- Clarinet
- Bassoon

III. Notation (記譜法)

- 1. Notation must not be too small
- 2. Musical note: stem & grouping
- 3. Bar number
- 4. Accidental
- 5. Tempo marking: references from metronome indication whenever possible
- 6. Instrument used: clearly labeled at the left margin of the score
- 7. For transposing instrument, score should be clearly marked whether it is a transposed score or score in C
- 8. Score should be printed on both sides of each sheet of paper
- 9. Types of binding: either "comb binding" or "stapled booklet"
- 10. Page turn
