




The Three-tier Implementation Model




Common characteristics of gifted students

8. **Knowledgeable** – strong knowledge base

The New “Screening Test”

- Roll out on a designated online platform
- Can be taken from any location within Hong Kong
- Candidates are required to use their own desktop computers or laptops, equipped with a webcam and stable internet access.
- Schools are advised to render necessary support for nominated students as appropriate.
 - Primary: 90 mins
 - Junior Secondary (S1-S3): 120 mins
 - Senior Secondary (S4-S5): 135 mins

The New “Screening Test”

Purposes:

1. Holistic Identification:

- ▶ To identify gifted students more comprehensively beyond academic performance

2. Multi-Dimensional Assessment:

- ▶ To assess different attributes of students

3. Streamlined Process:

- ▶ To simplify the whole process



26 Nov 2025 to 16 Dec 2025	Application/arrangement for the "Screening Test" and "Principal's Nomination"

Timeline

Date	Implementation
Mar to April 2026	Screening by the HKAGE
Late Apr 2026	Nomination results announcement and member registration
Late May 2026	Activate the HKAGE accounts and check account information

Target Participants

- The HKAGE provides services to student members aged 10 to 18 who are currently studying in schools in Hong Kong.
- Students are required to **meet the minimum age of 10 on or before 30 September 2026** to apply for the "Screening Test".
- Secondary students in their final year are not eligible, as their membership would commence close to their graduation.

“Principal’s Nomination Scheme”

- Each **secondary** school can nominate ONE student from **Secondary 2 to Secondary 4** for the **leadership domain**.
- Each **primary and secondary** school can nominate ONE student of appropriate age for the **visual arts domain**.
- These nominated students are exempted from the “Screening Test” and will be invited to submit their personal profiles for assessment.

Quota Limitation

- Each school can nominate **up to 10 students** per school year for the “Screening Test”.
(Applications under “Parent Nomination” and “Principal’s Nomination” are not included in this count)
- For “Parent Nomination,” parents and students must ensure that all required information is fully completed on the application form before submission. Any incomplete submissions will render the application ineligible for consideration.



Other Important Notes

1. The “Screening Test” is conducted on a designated online platform and can be taken from any location within Hong Kong. Candidates are required to use their own desktop computers or laptops, equipped with a webcam and stable internet access. Schools are advised to render necessary support for nominated students as appropriate.
2. Students can apply once per school year, either through “School Nomination” or “Parent Nomination”.



Other Important Notes

3. Students who have applied for the "Screening Test" via "School Nomination" cannot apply for another "Screening Test" via "Parent Nomination". The HKAGE will only consider the **"School Nomination"**.
4. Students already enrolled in the "Screening Test" cannot participate in the "Principal's Nomination" in the same school year.



Other Important Notes

5. To change application channels, students must notify the HKAGE via email to withdraw their original application and submit a new one.

6. Applicants must provide accurate and valid email addresses. All application changes, including withdrawals, must be submitted via email.

If students and parents do not receive application results or login details after the new “Screening Test” begins, please contact the HKAGE at sss@hkage.org.hk immediately.



Other Important Notes

7. The HKAGE may request supporting documents at any time or contact your child's school to verify their enrolment. Providing false information will result in the immediate cancellation of the application, and the parent or guardian may be held criminally liable.



School Coordinator

- Each school should assign one **School Coordinator** for communication purposes.
- For “Principal’s Nomination”, the **school coordinator will be required to submit personal profiles for students during January 2026.**



School Coordinator

- In late October, a letter will be sent to schools with the following:
 - Review and confirm the list of the HKAGE members currently enrolled at your school, and confirm whether the students on the list are still attending your school.
 - Nominate students to participate in the new "Screening Test" and "Principal's Nomination".

Prepare Nomination Information (for student(s) who are nominated via “Principal’s Nomination” Leadership Domain)

(Submitted by School Coordinator)

- Nomination reasons #
- **2-minute video by student on leadership experiences and insights # ***
- Parent’s observation of nominee #
- School reports in the previous school year #
- The Student Nominee & Parent Declaration Statement #
- Up to 3 significant achievements of supporting documents:
 - can be from any subject area
 - should demonstrate gifted attributes
- 1 creative work in any format:
 - audio/video, written work (stories, poems, lyrics, scripts, etc.), research studies, science / engineering / technology inventions, visual arts
- Up to 2 additional information
- Intellectual assessment reports (Optional)

Compulsory items

* If the video is longer than two minutes, the HKAGE will only consider the first two minutes of the content for assessment.



Group Interview

(for student(s) who are nominated via “Principal’s Nomination” Leadership Domain)

- Students are required to attend a 20-minute group interview at the HKAGE.
- Due to the large number of students participating in nominations and interviews, all students involved in the interviews will be randomly assigned an interview time.
- If a student is unable to attend the interview, it will be considered as withdrawing the nomination application.
- The interview will be held in late January 2026.



Prepare Nomination Information (for student(s) who are nominated via “Principal’s Nomination” Visual Arts Domain)

(Submitted by School Coordinator)

- Nomination reasons #
- **Up to 3 softcopies of artworks of any kind, with descriptions of 50 words max per artwork. #**
- Parent’s observation of nominee #
- School reports in the previous school year #
- The Student Nominee & Parent Declaration Statement #
- Up to 3 significant achievements of supporting documents:
 - can be from any subject area
 - should demonstrate gifted attributes
- 1 creative work in any format:
 - audio/video, written work (stories, poems, lyrics, scripts, etc.), research studies, science/engineering/technology inventions, visual arts
- Intellectual assessment reports (Optional)
