Gifted Education School Network 2025/26 and Relevant Professional Training Programmes for Teachers

Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to invite primary and secondary schools to participate in the "Gifted Education School Network" and the relevant professional training programmes for teachers organised by the Education Bureau (EDB).

Background

2. EDB has been attaching great importance to nurturing gifted students and continues to provide professional support to schools, including "Gifted Education School Network", assist schools in the implementation of school-based gifted programmes and equip teachers with the professional capacity to identify and nurture students with potential in various areas through the setting up and effective use of school-based student talent pool. In addition, to facilitate professional exchange, EDB organises the Gifted Education School Network Experience Sharing Sessions to invite network schools to share their experiences in implementing school-based gifted education and the outcomes.

Details

Gifted Education School Network 2025/26

- 3. EDB has been encouraging schools to participate in the "Gifted Education School Network" and now invites application from primary and secondary schools for "Gifted Education School Network" 2025/26 (the Network) to be held in the next school year. Through the "Gifted Education School Network", we build a professional learning community to facilitate experience sharing and professional exchanges. We also support the ongoing enhancement of school-based gifted programmes and development of learning and teaching resources for schools to provide appropriate nurturing for gifted students, and promote the effective use of school-based student talent pool in schools.
- 4. Network meetings, inter-school visits and experience sharing sessions are organised for the Network. By conducting the above-mentioned professional exchange activities, EDB assists schools to plan and implement their school-based gifted education. The Network covers various Key Learning Areas/ domains, including Chinese Language, English Language, Mathematics and STEAM education. Participating teachers can explore effective strategies to address the learning and affective needs of gifted students with teachers of the same Key

Learning Areas/ domains. Through collaborative lesson planning, lesson tryouts, lesson observations and evaluations, teachers can observe each other with professional exchange for the continuous enhancement of school-based gifted education.

5. The Network is now open for application. Schools who join "Gifted Education School Network" 2024/25 are required to resubmit an application if they wish to continue to participate in the Network. For details regarding the Network, please visit EDB website

Principals and teachers from primary and secondary schools are also invited to share their experience of developing school-based gifted education with the theme of aerospace and aviation to nurture gifted students with potential in STEAM. Principals are invited to nominate teachers to participate in the aforementioned sharing sessions. Details of the Sharing Sessions are as below:
