### **Developing Students' Creativity** through Riddle Writing in the English Classroom

### The objectives: At the end of the lesson, students will be **able to...**

> Write a riddle creatively with the use of similes 'like' and

'as...as' and adjectives. (Cooperative learning)

- > Present the riddle with the use of Padlet. (IT in Education)
- > Appreciate language arts in a long run. (Culture)

### The lesson design

Teaching procedures	Objectives
<ol> <li>Self-learning / Watch a video as preparation</li> </ol>	Arousing students' learning interest and providing a self-learning opportunity as a pre-task.
2. Revising some opposite adjectives and the use of similes	Teaching students how to write creatively with similes- <b>"asas" or/and "like"</b>
3. Teaching a writing model	Demonstrating a writing model about Kate Middleton with a given mind map, in order to teach students how to use adjectives, connectives and similes cooperatively and creatively.
<ol> <li>Cooperative learning/ Creative writing/ Showcasing the learning outcomes</li> </ol>	Encouraging students to have more higher-order thinking for their creative writing task. Students can share their riddle poem with padlet in class.



# Key structure (TB P.5) These are similes. We use them to describe something by comparing it to something else. He was as fierce as a tiger.





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
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# Conclusion: Why creative writing?
