Sample (5) Answer

In Figure (a), A, B, C, D and E are five different points on a line. Line segments are formed by marking any two points on this line. For example, AB, AC and BD are three line segments. How many different line segments are there in Figure (a) ?

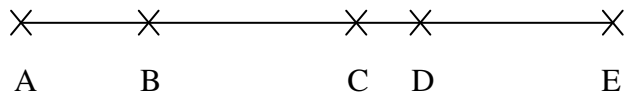

Answer: There are 10 different line segments.

(b) There are many different triangles in Figure (b), such as $\triangle VAB$, $\triangle VAC$ and $\triangle VBD$. How many different triangles are there in Figure (b) ?

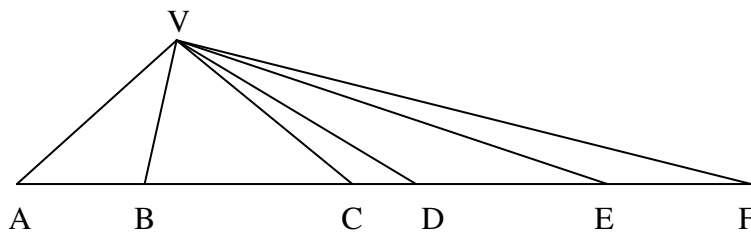

Answer : There are 15 different triangles.
