





Baskets, crates and cages, other than pig crates, shall be large enough to allow free movement in all directions of every animal therein.



- Cap 169 <u>Prevention</u> to Cruelty to Animals Ordinance 《<u>防止殘酷</u>對待動物條例》 [29 November 1935]
- Penalty for cruelty to animals
- (1) Any person who—
- (a)
- cruelly beats, kicks, ill-treats, over-rides, over-drives, overloads, tortures, infuriates, or terrifies any animal, or causes or procures or, being the owner, permits any animal to be so used, or, by wantonly or unreasonably doing or omitting to do any act, causes any unnecessary suffering or, being the owner, permits any unnecessary suffering to be so caused to any animal; or

(a) To introduce a positive 'Duty of Care'

#### The Concept of 'Duty of Care'

- 3. Duty of care to an animal means that a person responsible for the animal must take such steps as are reasonable in the circumstances to ensure its welfare needs are met. The person(s) responsible for the animal include(s) not only the owner, but also someone in charge of, or having custody of the animal, whether permanently or temporarily. The following animal welfare needs should be met to the extent required by good practice:
  - (a) the need for suitable nutrition;
  - (b) the need for a suitable environment;
  - (c) the need to be able to exhibit normal patterns of behaviour (including social needs); and
  - (d) the need to be protected from pain, suffering, disease and injury.


- Public Health (Animals and Birds) (Trading and Breeding) Regulations (Cap139B)
- Need *license\** to sell or breed
- Or a one-off *permit* ( with requirement)
- \* Fulfill the Code of Practice
- Maximum penalty is \$10,000




