- (1) Participants are required to have 100% attendance of the Course.
  - (2) The target participants are non-language subject teachers who have met the "teacher capability" criterion in teaching in the English medium. To meet the "teacher capability" criterion, non-language subject teachers adopting EMI teaching should have a Grade C or above in English Language (Syllabus B) of the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE) (From 2007 to 2011, the HKCEE for English Language adopted a standards-reference assessment and the proficiency requirement is pitched at Level 3 or above. Upon the introduction of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination in 2012, the proficiency requirement is pitched at Level 3 or above in English Language.).
