Objective(s)

The course aims to help teacher participants to develop and enhance their understanding of: 1. the role of language in learning; 2. the English language patterns of the science genres of information report, process explanation, factorial and consequential explanation, procedure, recount and hypothesis making; 3. the planning, teaching and assessment pedagogies to support their students’ effective learning of the Science Education KLA using English as the medium of instruction within the different school contexts in Hong Kong; and 4. the need to evaluate, reflect on and improve their own teaching to support their students’ better learning in the Science Education KLA using English as the medium of instruction. The post-course support will aim to further develop and enhance this understanding. Participants will also be supported to: 5. develop the awareness of and competency in refining their content-language teaching pedagogies and resources for continuous professional

	development purposes; and 6. gauge and evaluate their students' progress in content-language learning through assessment of, for and as learning. The e-platform will play a major role in collecting and disseminating good practices of effective teaching of the Science Education KLA using English as the medium of instruction.

Remarks

1) To be considered completing the course, participants are required to have attended at least 80% of the taught sessions and complete the post-course support;

(2) The aim of the course is to enhance the competency of Science Education KLA teachers who have met the “teacher capability” criterion for teaching in the English medium. As this course is meant to be an in-depth programme catering for the needs of Science Education KLA, priority for admission will be given to teachers who have experience in teaching Science Education KLA in the English medium;

(3) In case of over-subscription, at most two teachers from each school may be considered for admission according to the priority set by the Principal;

(4) Successful applicants will be notified by mail by EdUHK not later than 14 calendar days before the commencement of the class; and

(5) Special Arrangements for Bad Weather

a. Course / Activity for morning session will be cancelled when Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued at or after 6:30 am.

b. Course / Activity for afternoon session will be resumed when Typhoon Signal No.8 or above or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled at or before 11:30 am. Otherwise, Course / Activity for afternoon session will continue to be cancelled.
