Initiation Programme for Newly Arrived Children:

The full-time six-month Initiation Programme is an integrated programme provided as an alternative mode of support services for the children just arriving Hong Kong, including children from the Mainland, non-Chinese speaking children and returnee children. The children can choose to attend this programme prior to their joining the mainstream schools.

The Education Bureau will undertake to place the children completing the programme to suitable secondary or primary schools.

Objectives:

- To enhance the participating children's academic standard, in particular in Chinese and English.
- To foster their personal development and social adaptation.
- To strengthen their learning experience / exposure to real classroom situation.

Programme Contents:

The contents of the programme include:

- English language
- Chinese language
- Academic subjects
- Learning skills
- Personal development
- Social adaptation
- Physical and cultural education
- Basic IT knowledge
